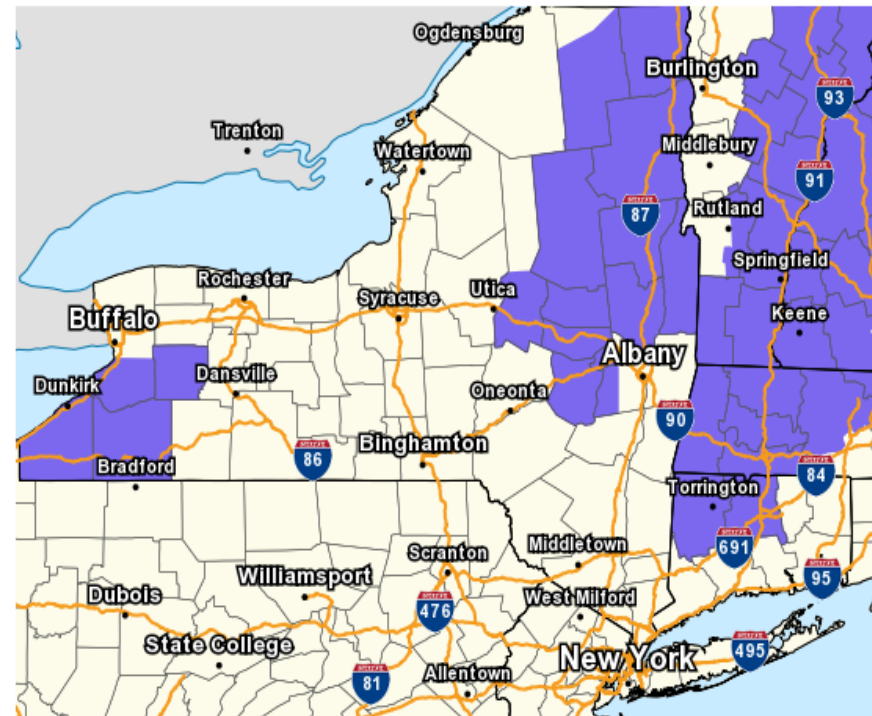
## What Has Changed?

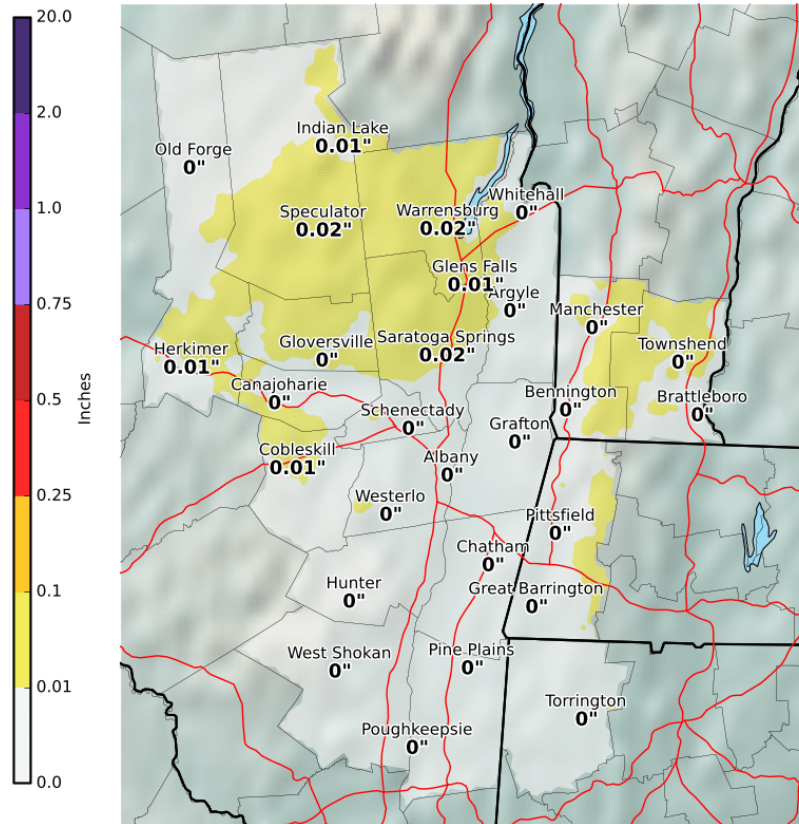

- ✓ **Untreated roads and sidewalks will be slippery**

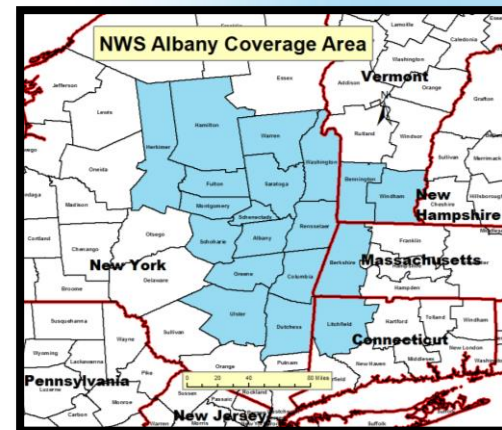
