



Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Snow	An additional inch of snow. Total accumulations of 3 to 6 inches, resulting in slippery travel and reduced visibilities.	Northern Herkimer and Hamilton Counties	Through 1 pm Today
Wind	Gusts to 50 mph could blow down unsecured objects. Tree limbs could be blown down, resulting in scattered power outages.	The Green Mountains in southern Vermont, western Massachusetts, and the Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Capital District, and northern and central Taconics, eastern Catskills, and Fulton and Hamilton Counties in eastern New York	Through 7 pm Today







Event Summary

Additional snowfall possible across the Adirondacks early this morning... Strong winds over portions of eastern New York and western New England....

Confidence is HIGH that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts

ONAL WEATHER SERVICE

Period of greatest impact: Through the day today



An additional 1 inch of snow is possible, with total accumulation of 3 to 6 inches over the western Adirondacks, west of Speculator and Indian Lake. The snow will result in slippery travel conditions and reduced visibility.



Winds of 15 to 25 mph, with gusts up to 50 mph possible through 7 pm today in areas where the Wind Advisory is in effect. The gusts may blow around unsecured items and down tree limbs, resulting in scattered power outages.
