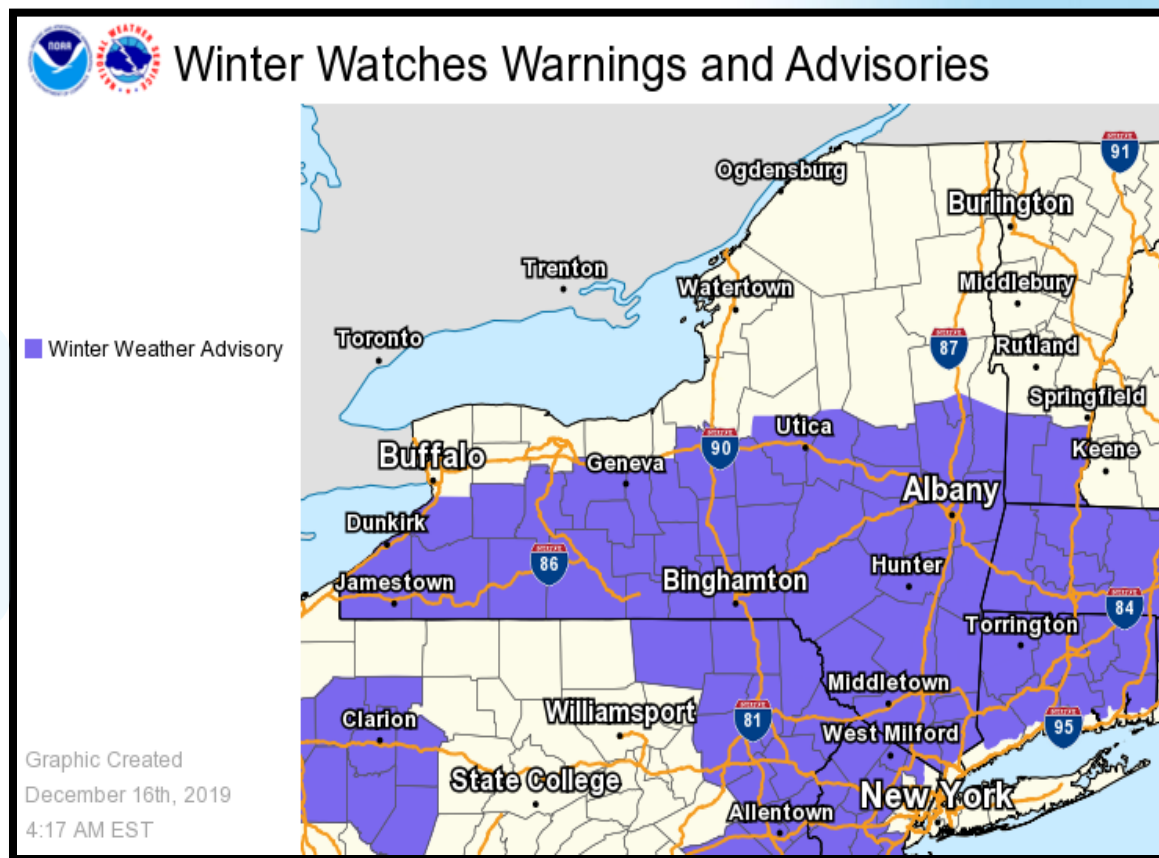


Winter Weather Expected Tuesday, Snow Squalls Wednesday, Followed by Frigid Temperatures Thursday

What Has Changed?

- ✓ *Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for the entire forecast area except the southern Adirondacks and northern Washington and Warren counties.*



Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wintry Mix of Snow, Sleet, Freezing Rain 	<p>Snow this evening will change over to a wintry mix around daybreak Tuesday. Wintry mix changes back over to snow Tuesday evening before ending. Storm total snow accumulation of <u>2 to 5 inches</u>, with up to a <u>tenth of an inch of ice</u>. Hazardous travel is expected for both morning and evening commutes Tuesday.</p>	<p>Eastern Catskills, mid-Hudson Valley, southern Taconics, southern Berkshires and Litchfield, CT.</p>	<p>10 PM Today through 1 AM Wednesday</p>
Snow 	<p>Snow begins before daybreak Tuesday and ends Tuesday evening. Storm total snow accumulation of <u>3 to 6 inches</u>. Hazardous travel is expected for both morning and evening commutes Tuesday.</p>	<p>Northern Berkshires, Litchfield Hills, Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, Lake George/Saratoga region, and northern and western portions of the Capital District</p>	<p>1 AM Tuesday through 1 AM Wednesday</p>

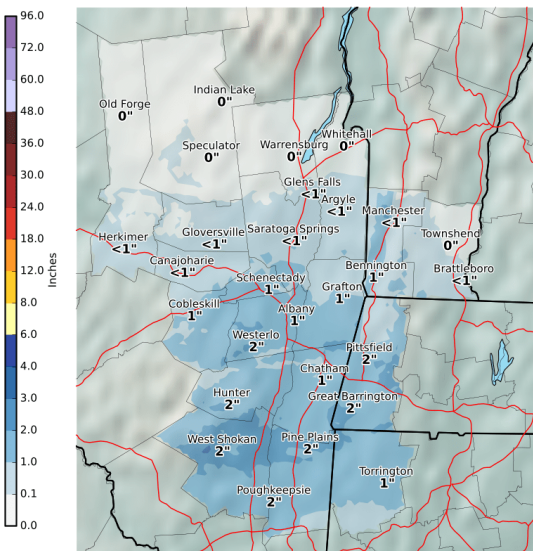
Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

Low End Amount - 9 in 10 Chance (90%) Of Higher Snowfall

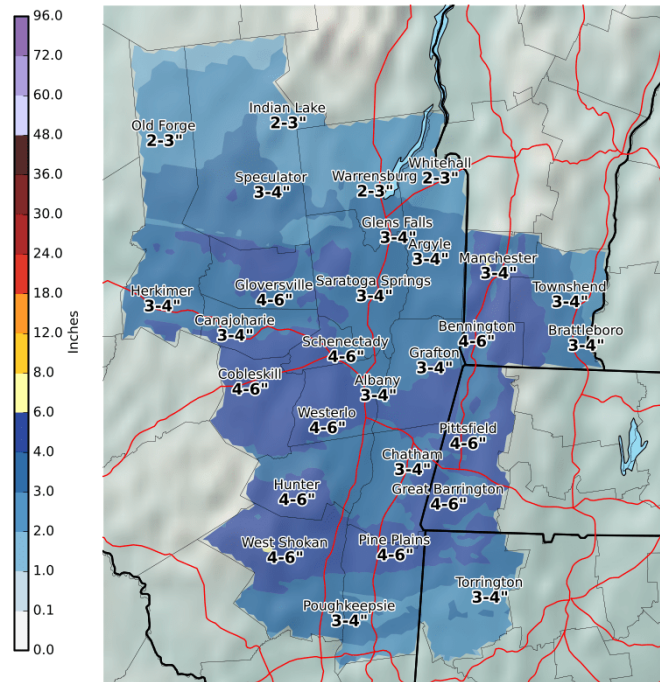

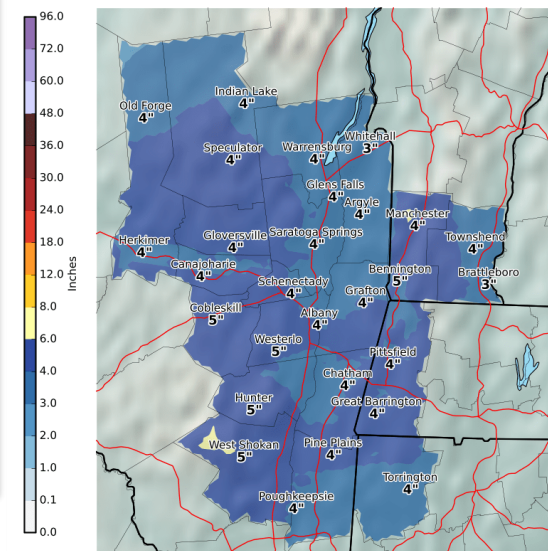

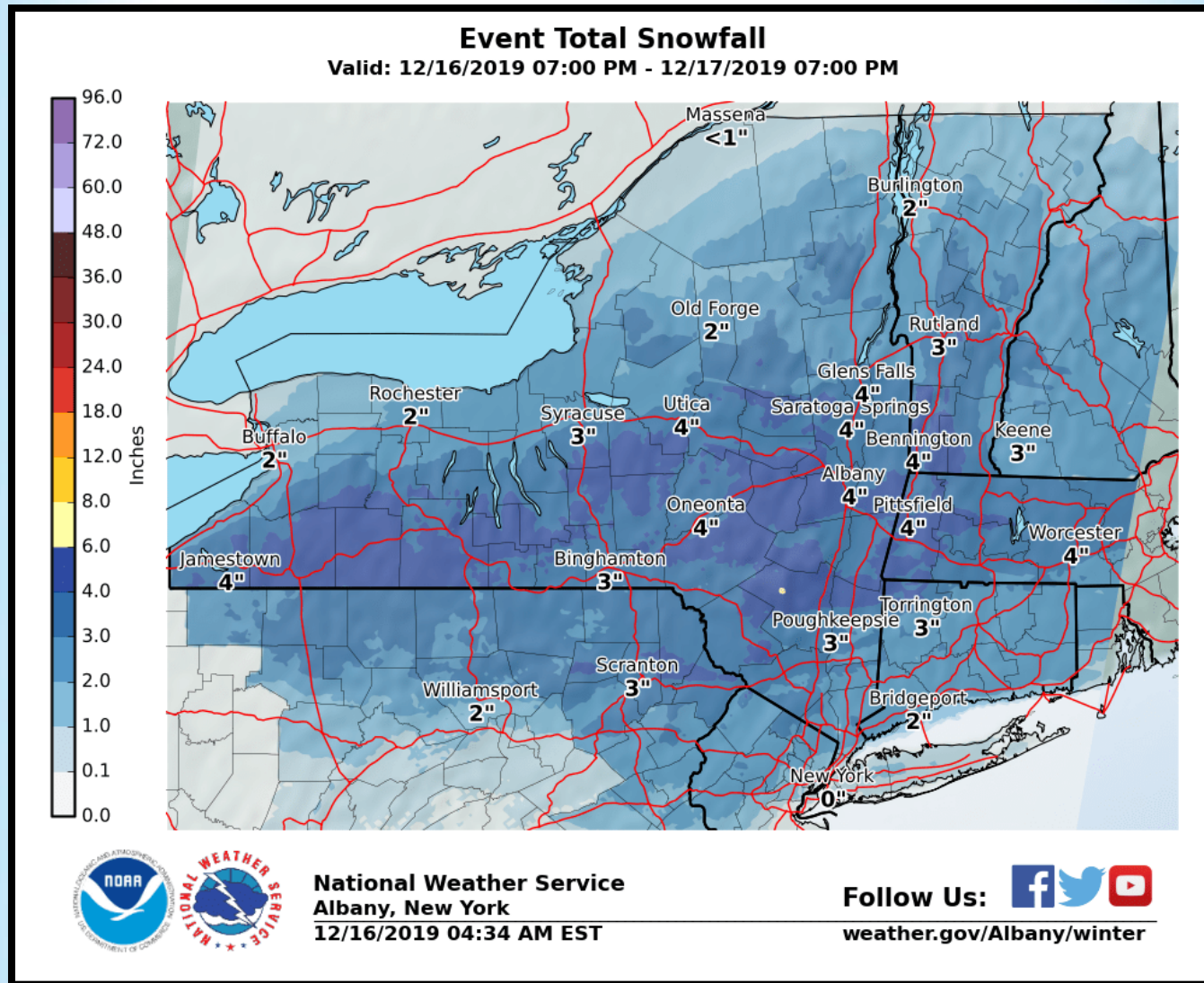
High End Amount - 1 in 10 Chance (10%) Of Higher Snowfall

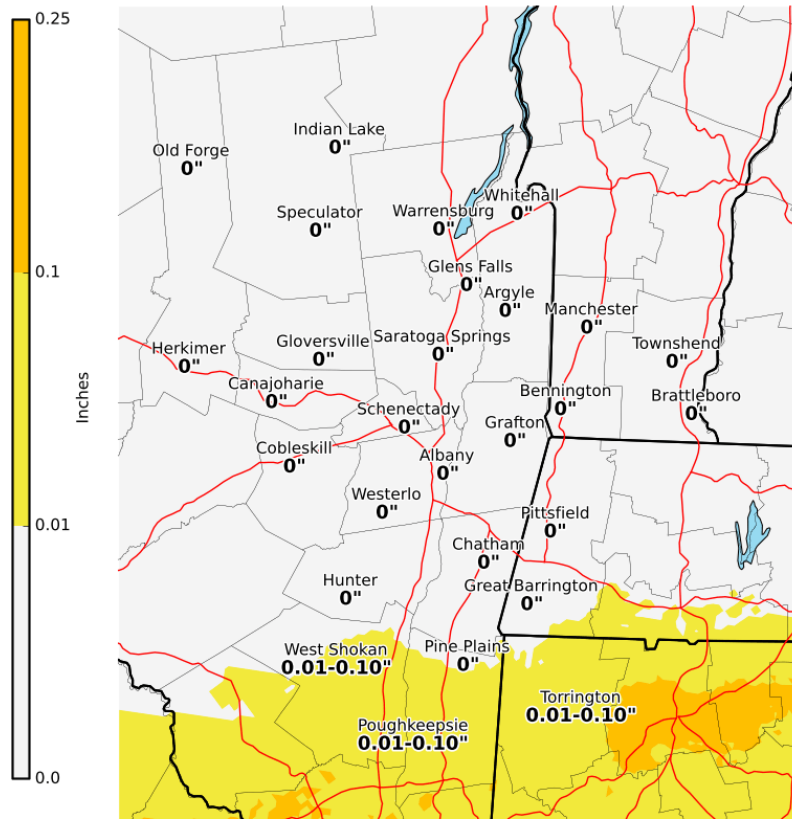

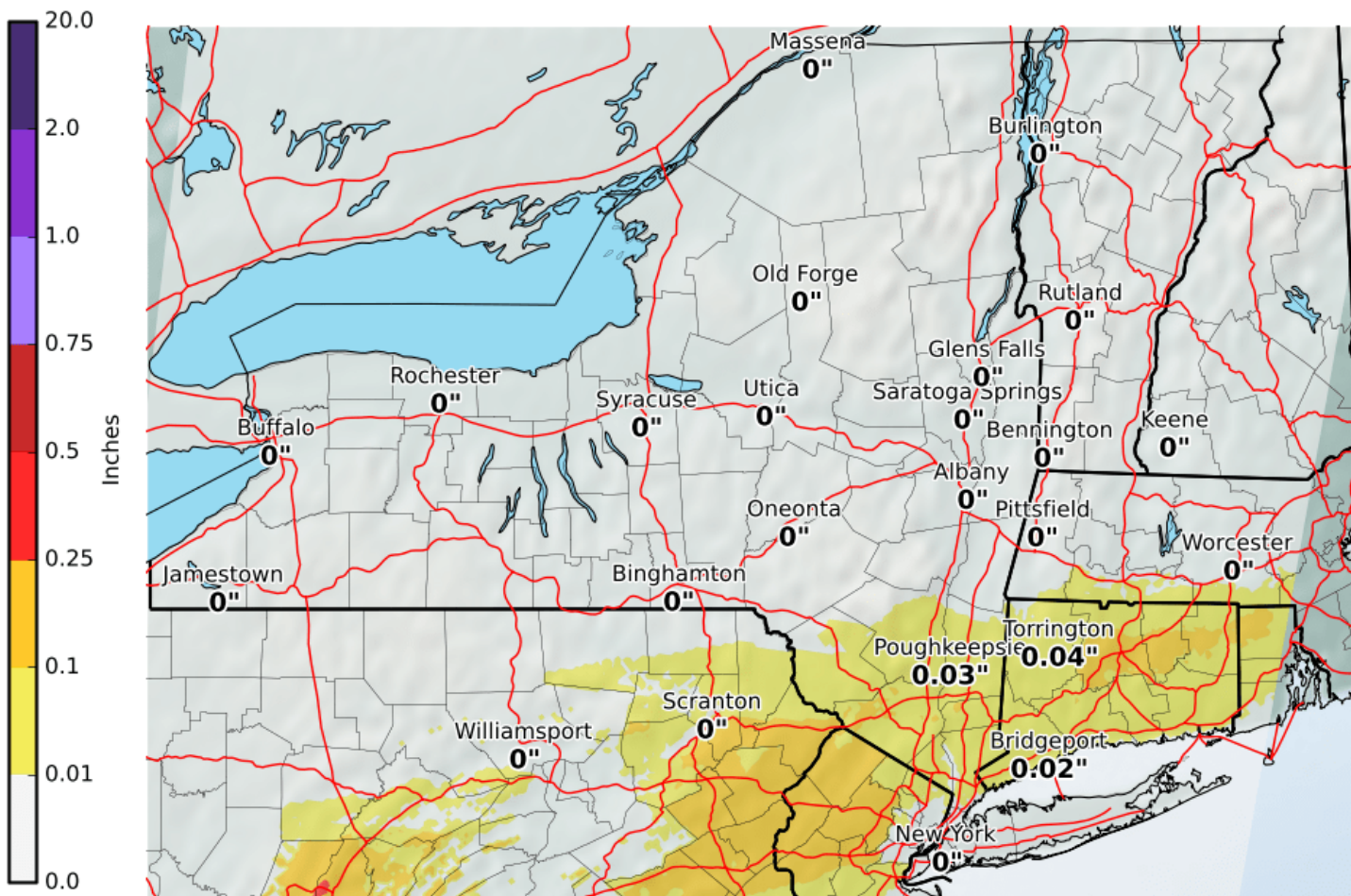

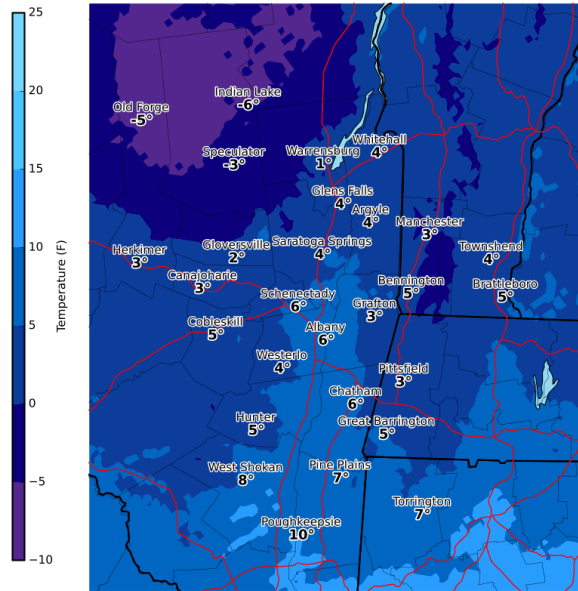

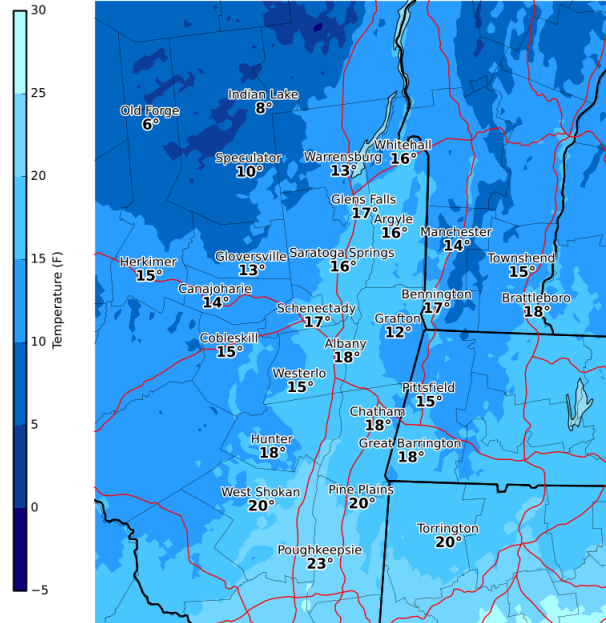
Thursday Morning

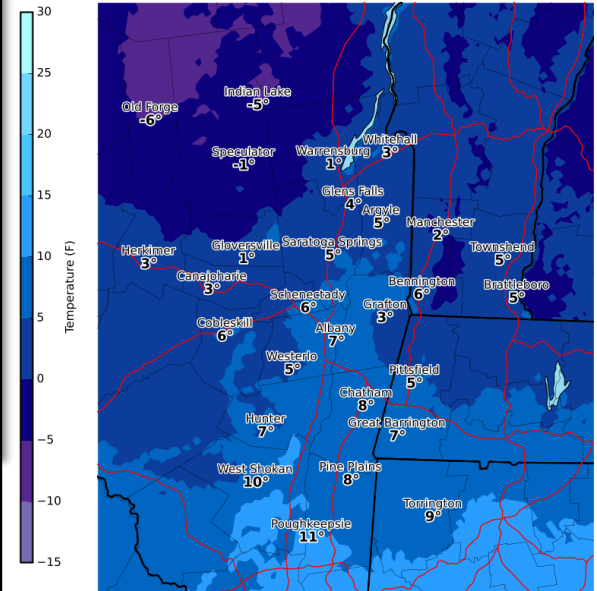
Thursday Afternoon High

Event Summary

Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for the entire forecast area except the southern Adirondacks and northern Washington/Warren counties for tonight through Tuesday evening...

Snow Squalls Possible Wednesday, followed by Frigid temperatures Thursday

- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that this winter weather event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: Tonight through Tuesday evening
- ✓ Hazardous Travel Expected during the morning and evening commutes Tuesday



Total snow accumulations of 2 to 5 inches, with up to a tenth of an inch of ice possible for the Eastern Catskills, mid-Hudson Valley, southern Taconics, southern Berkshires and Litchfield, CT.

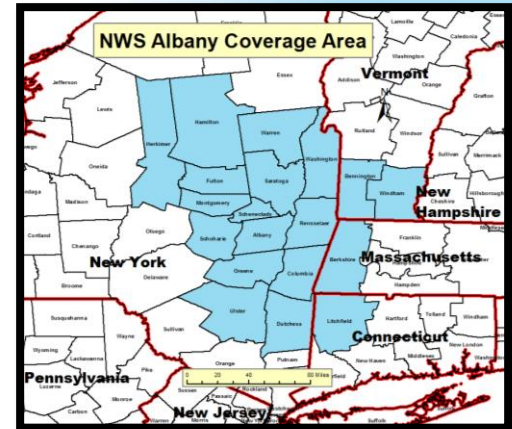
