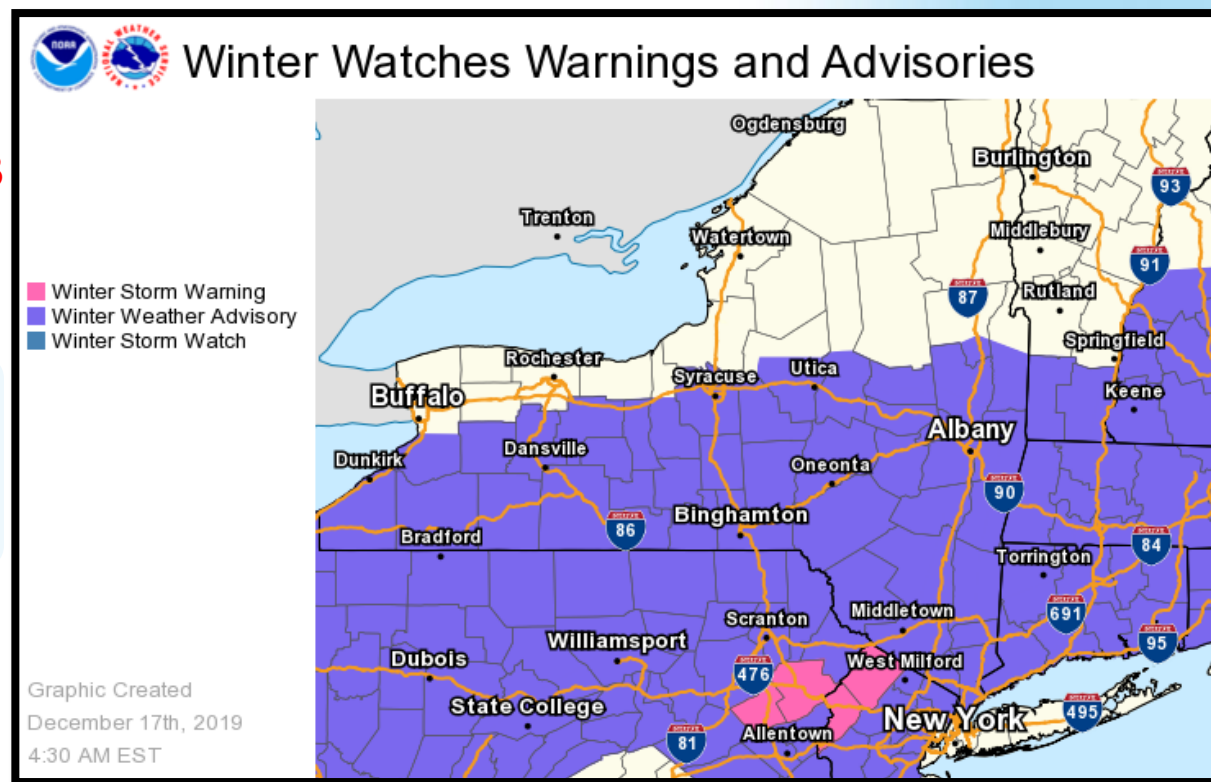



- ✓ *Snow amounts have decreased for Ulster, Dutchess and Litchfield counties.*

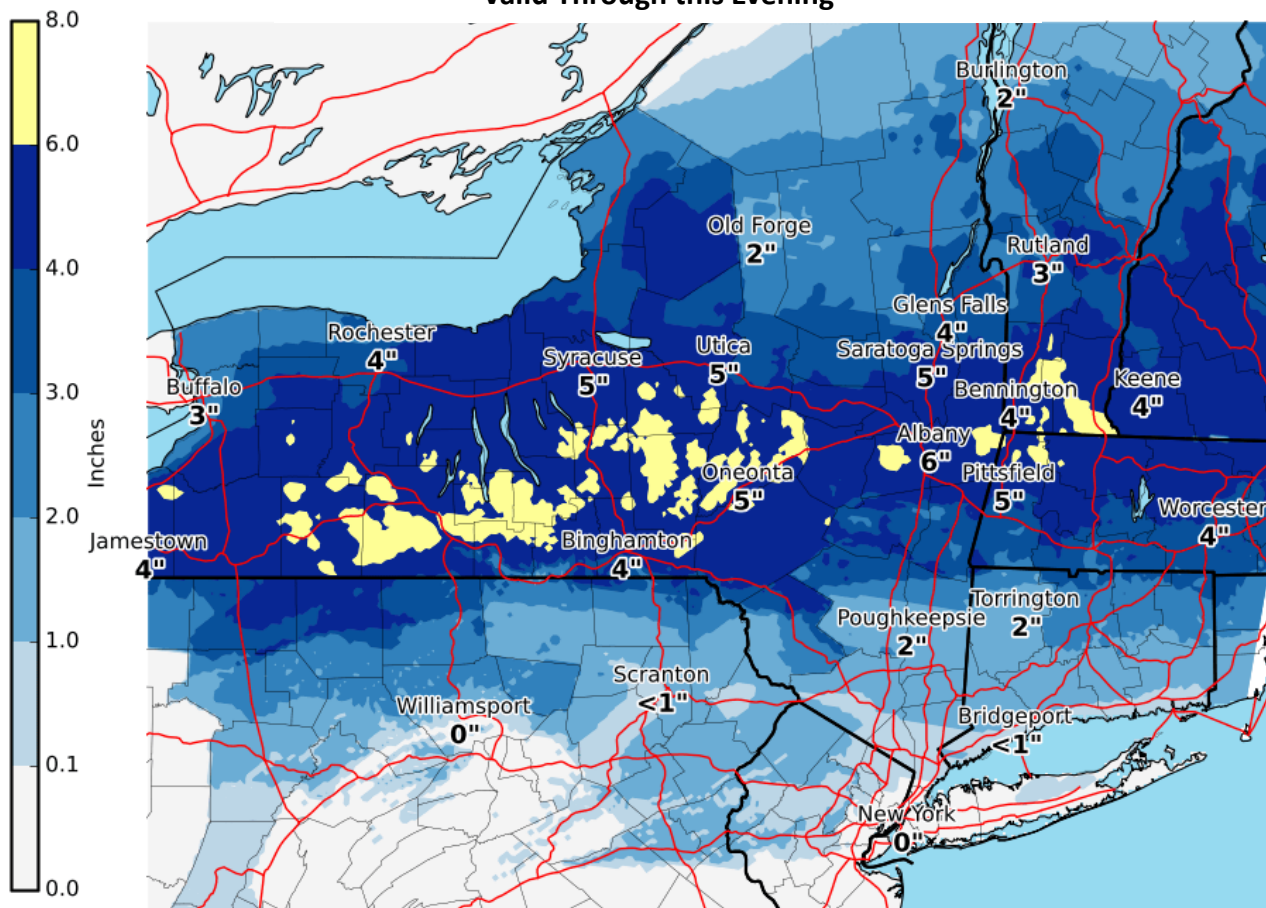


Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wintry Mix of Snow, Sleet, Freezing Rain 	<p>Snow will change over to a wintry mix by daybreak and continue for much of the day. Wintry mix changes back over to snow showers this evening before ending. Storm total snow accumulation of <u>1 to 4 inches</u>, with up to <u>two tenths of an inch of ice</u>. Hazardous travel is expected for both morning and evening commutes today.</p>	<p>Eastern Catskills, mid-Hudson Valley, southern Taconics, southern Berkshires and Litchfield, CT.</p>	<p>Through 10 PM This Evening</p>
Snow 	<p>Snow begins before daybreak and ends this evening. Storm total snow accumulation of <u>3 to 6 inches</u>, with <u>locally higher amounts in the high terrain</u>. Hazardous travel is expected for both morning and evening commutes today.</p>	<p>Northern Berkshires, Litchfield Hills, Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, Lake George/Saratoga region, and Capital District</p>	<p>Through 10 PM This Evening</p>

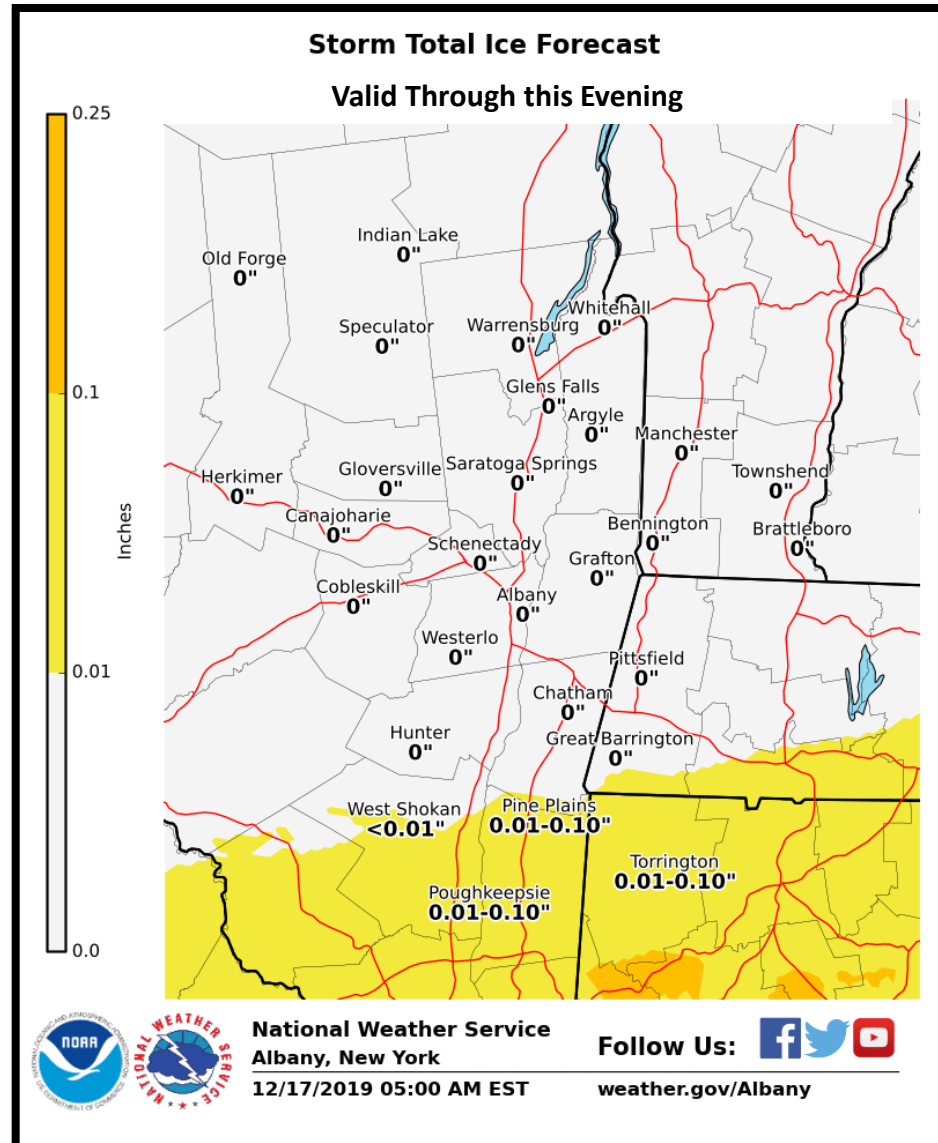
Storm Total Snow Forecast

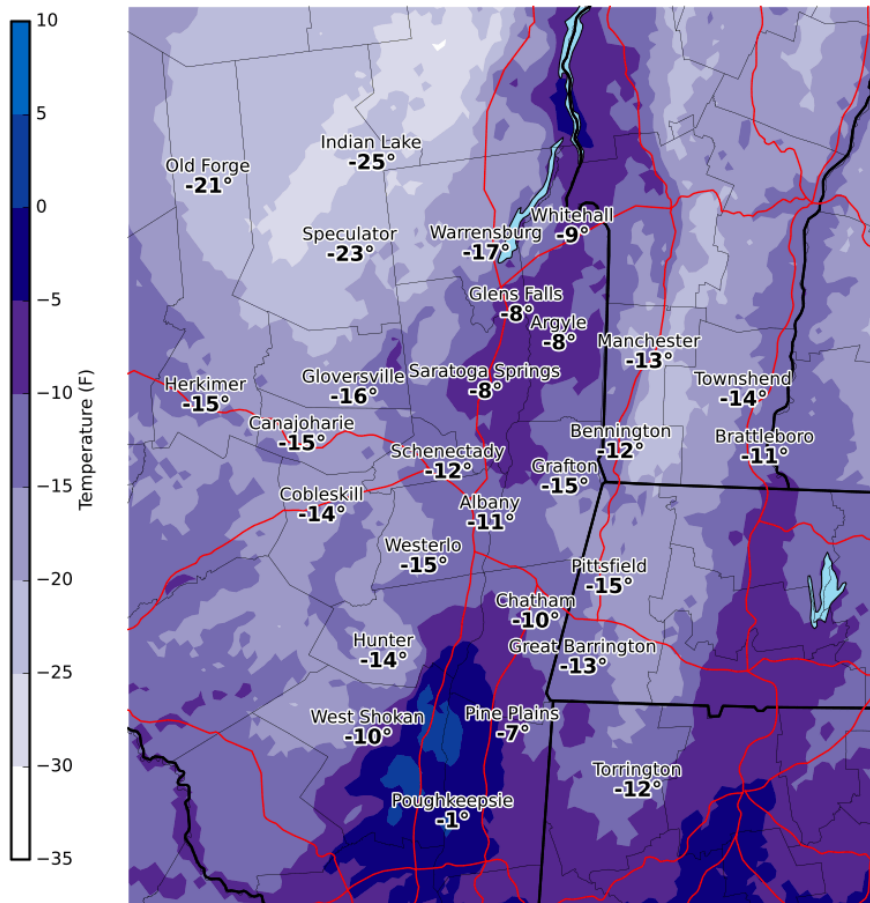

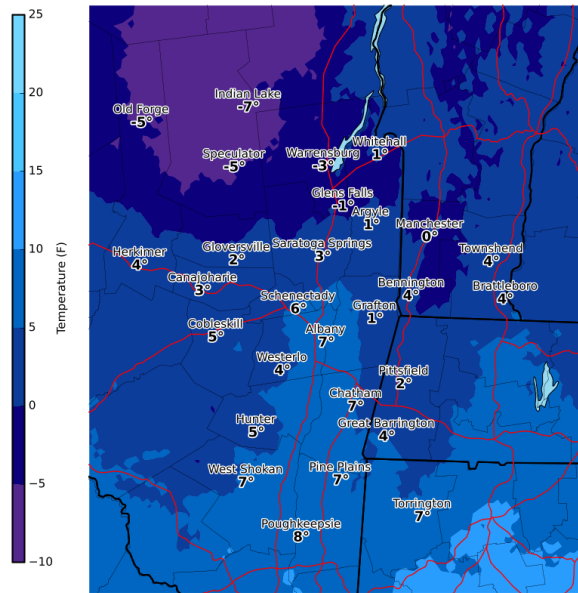

Thursday Afternoon

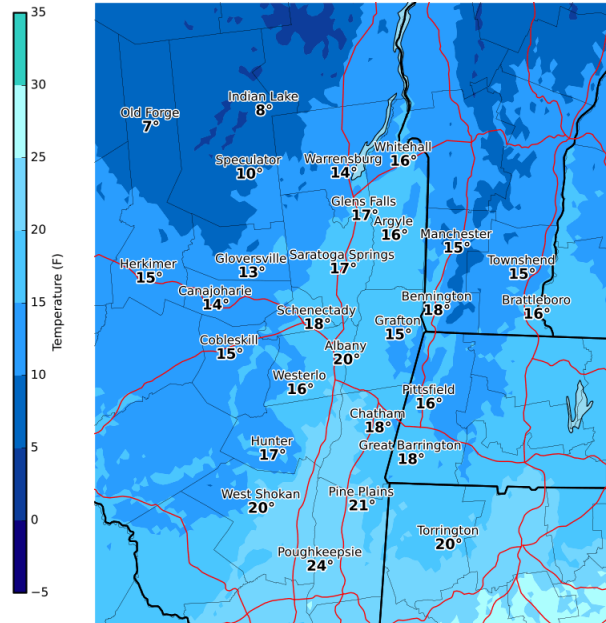
Thursday Morning

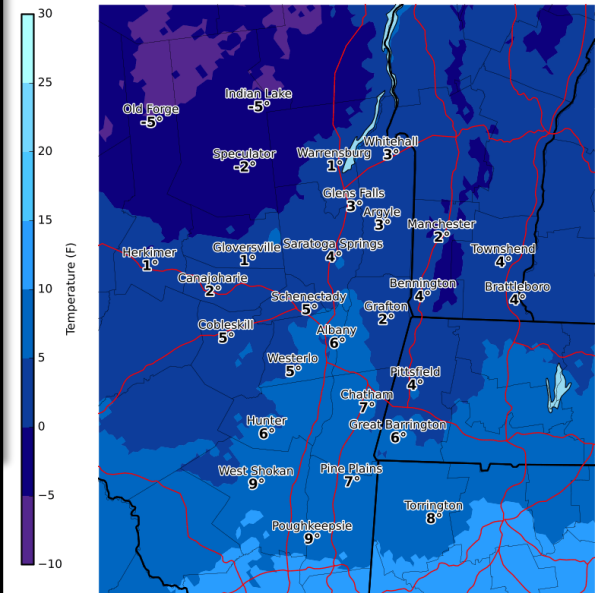
Thursday Afternoon Highs

Event Summary

Winter Weather Advisories remain in effect for the entire forecast area except the southern Adirondacks and northern Washington/Warren counties through this evening...

- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that this winter weather event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: Through this evening
- ✓ Hazardous Travel Expected during the morning and evening commutes today



Total snow accumulations of 1 to 4 inches, with up to two tenths of an inch of ice possible for the eastern Catskills, mid-Hudson Valley, southern Taconics, southern Berkshires and Litchfield, CT.



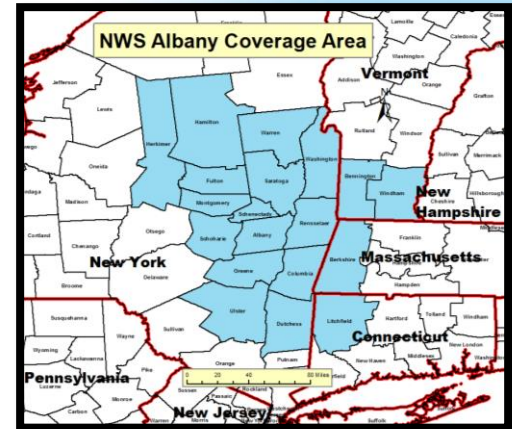
Total snow accumulations of 3 to 6 inches for the Northern Berkshires, Litchfield Hills, Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, Lake George/Saratoga region, and the Capital District, with locally higher amounts in the high terrain.
