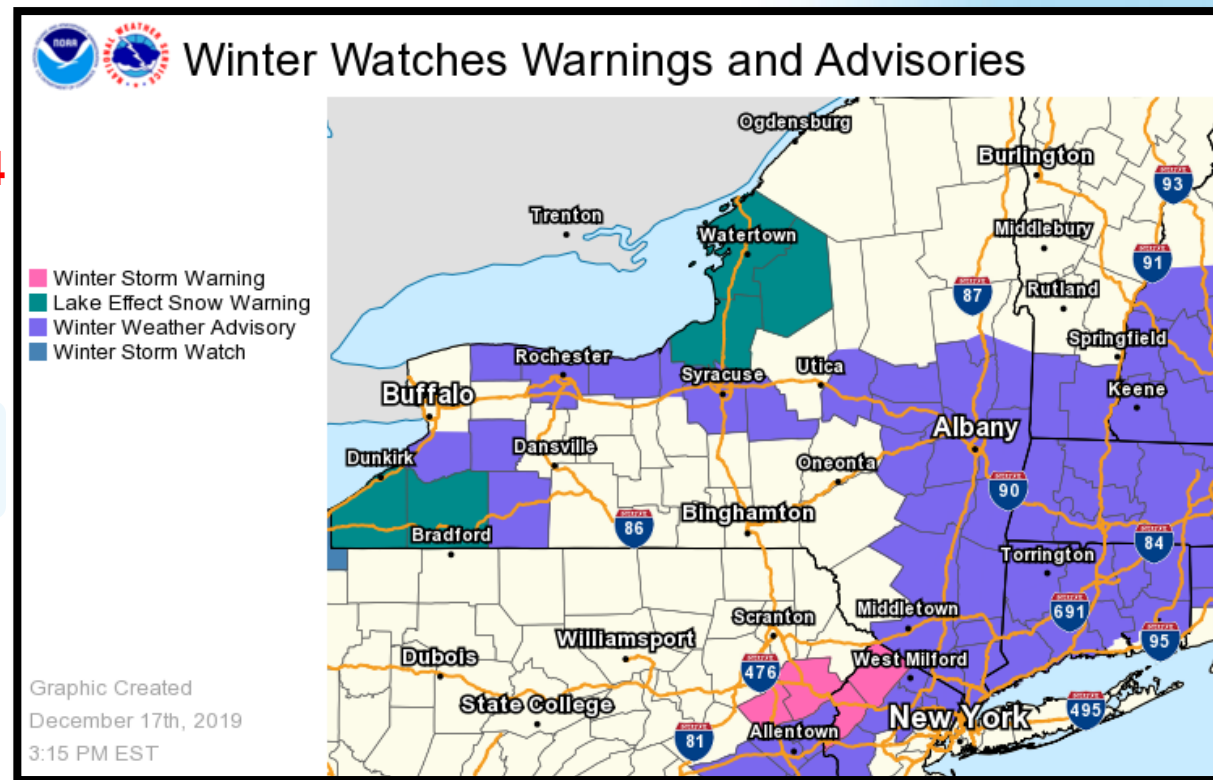

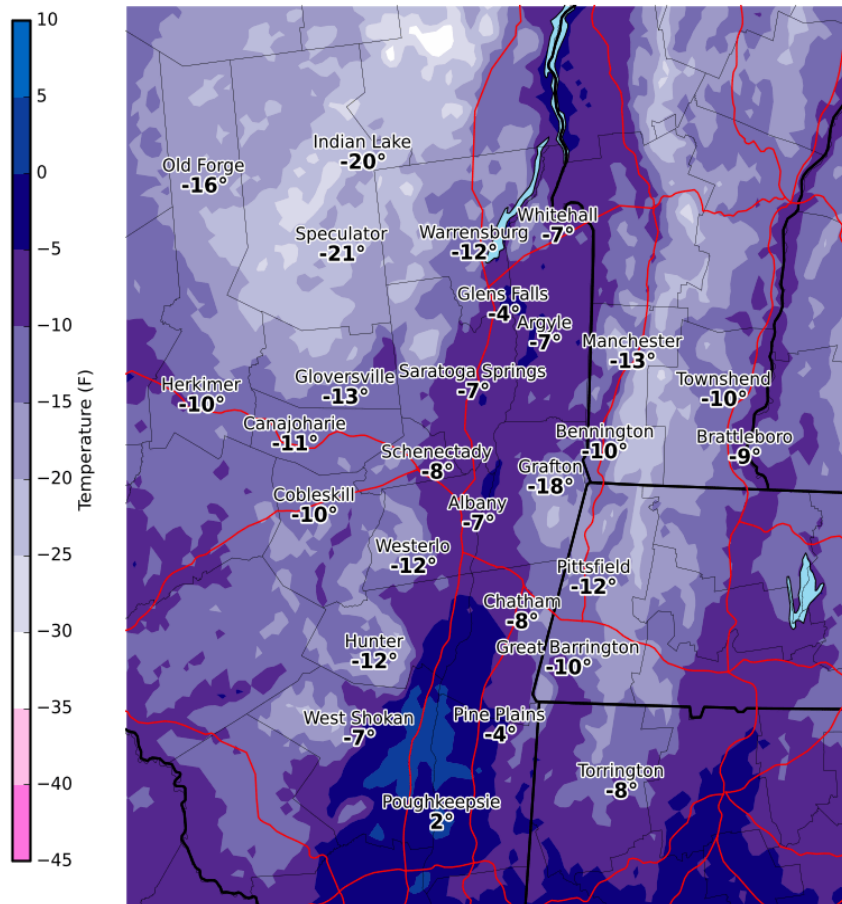

 <b>Snow &amp; Wintry Mix</b>	<p>Hazardous travel due to snow/sleet covered roads &amp; sidewalks expected for the evening commute today. Lingering snow showers &amp; wintry mix end this evening with Winter Weather Advisories ending by 10pm.</p>	<p>All areas expect for the Upper Hudson Valley, southern Adirondacks.</p>	<p>This Evening Through 10PM</p>
 <b>Snow Squalls</b>	<p>Rapid changes to visibility including brief whiteout conditions in any snow squall. Very Dangerous travel conditions.</p>	<p>All areas of eastern NY and western New England</p>	<p>Wednesday Mainly between 10am and 5pm.</p>
 <b>Cold Temperatures &amp; Wind Chill</b>	<p>Very cold temperatures combined with strong winds could lead to dangerous wind chills between -15°F and -25°F.</p>	<p>Southern Adirondacks, Berkshires, Catskills and southern Green Mountains</p>	<p>Wed night into early Thursday</p>

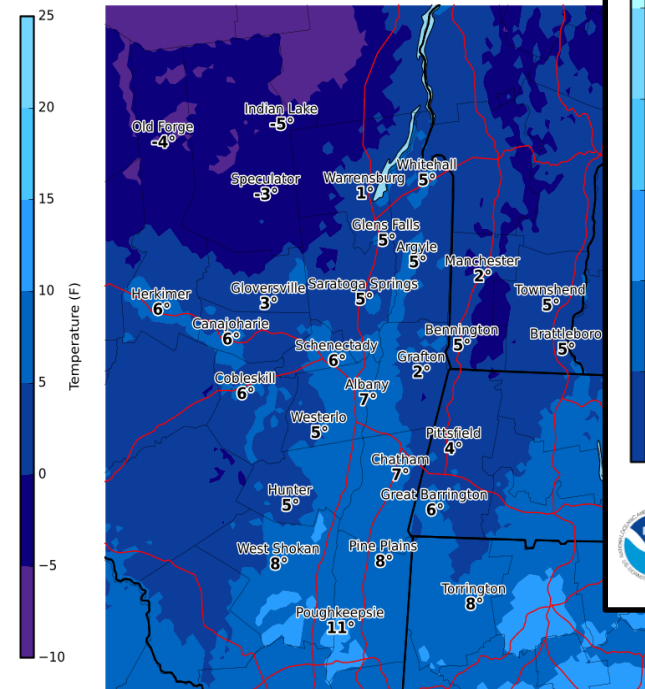

### Thursday Morning

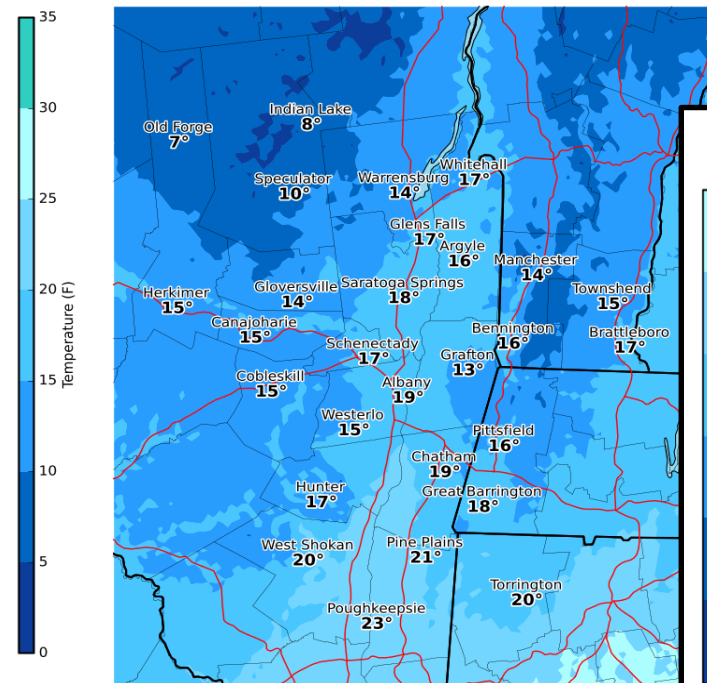

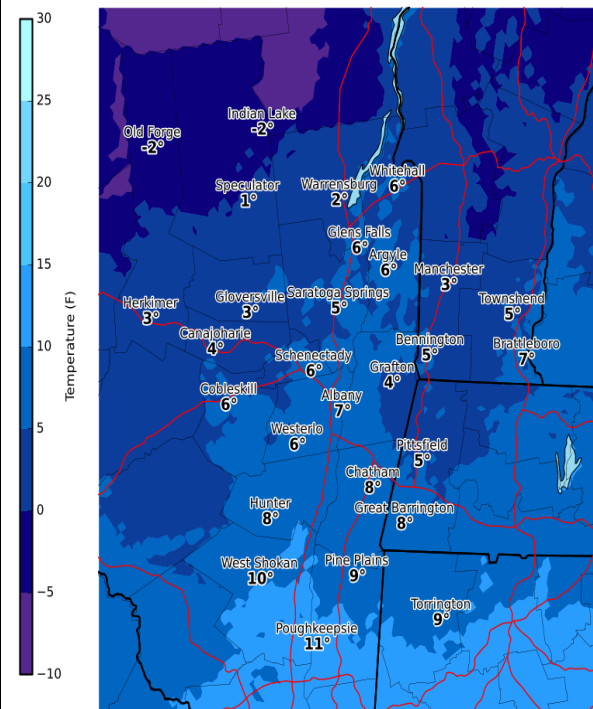

## Event Summary

**Winter Weather Advisories will end this evening for the entire forecast area except for the southern Adirondacks & northern Washington/Warren counties.**

- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that snow squalls will occur tomorrow and **MODERATE** on expected impacts.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact for Snow Squalls: Tomorrow 10AM to 5PM
- ✓ Dangerous Travel Conditions Expected During Any Snow Squalls. This may include the Wednesday Evening Commute



Snow Squalls tomorrow will lead to rapidly changing visibility including brief whiteout conditions.

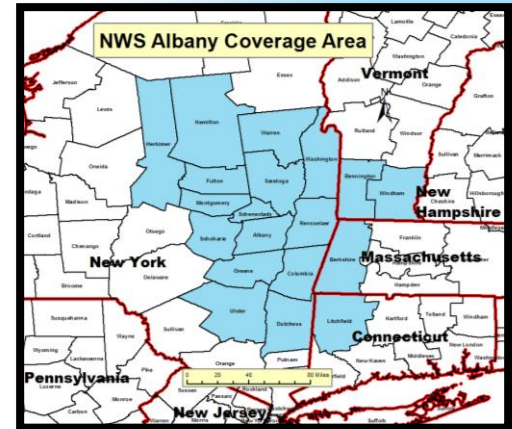


Very cold temperatures combined with strong winds Wed night into early Thursday will lead to dangerous wind chill values between -15°F and -25°F in the southern Adirondacks, southern Green Mountains, Catskills and Berkshires. Wind Chill Advisories may be needed.
