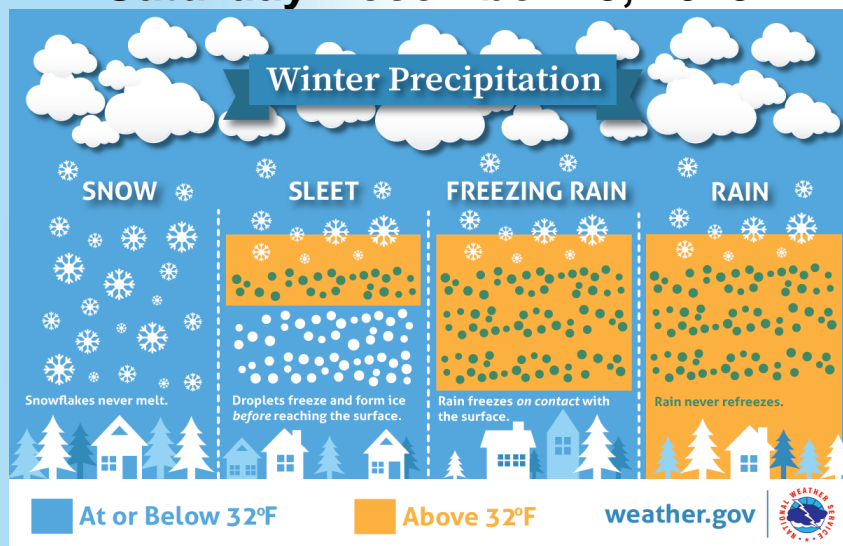

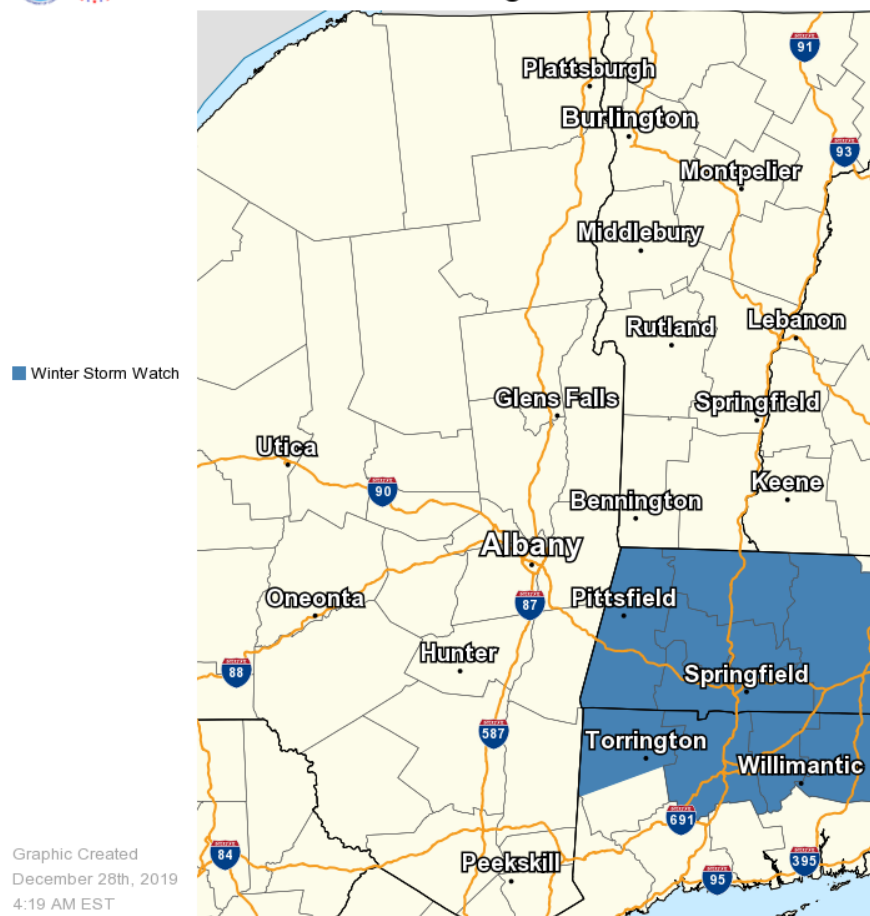

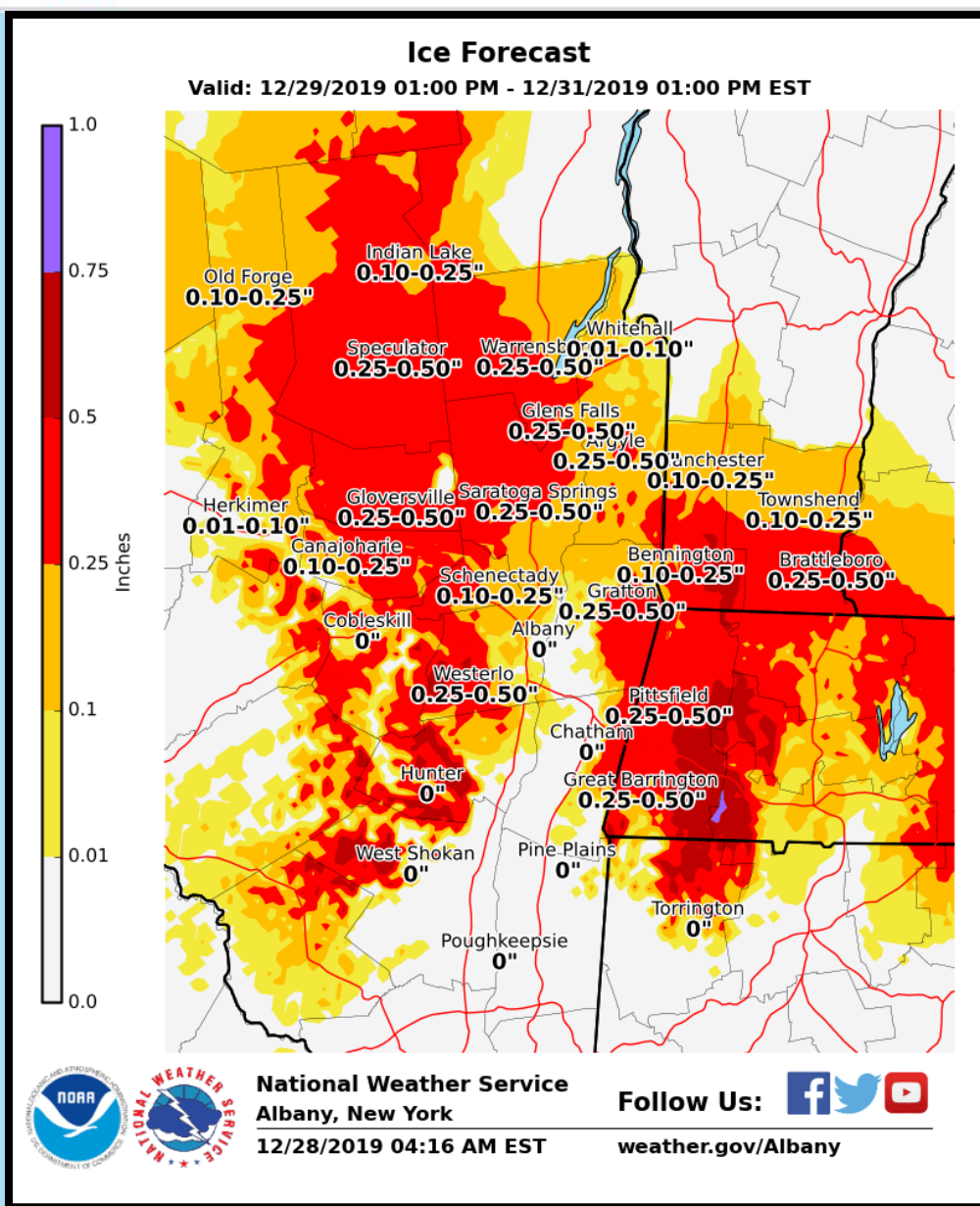
- ✓ A Winter Storm Watch has been issued for the Berkshires and Litchfield Hills for Sunday evening into Tuesday afternoon

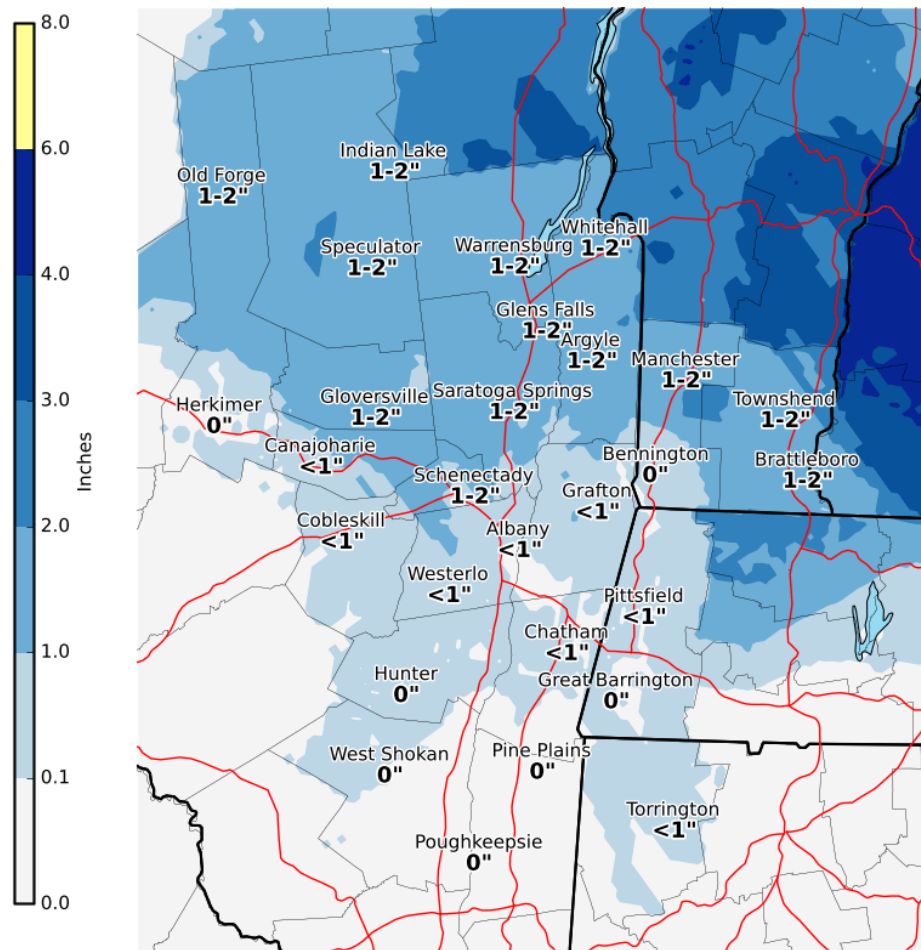

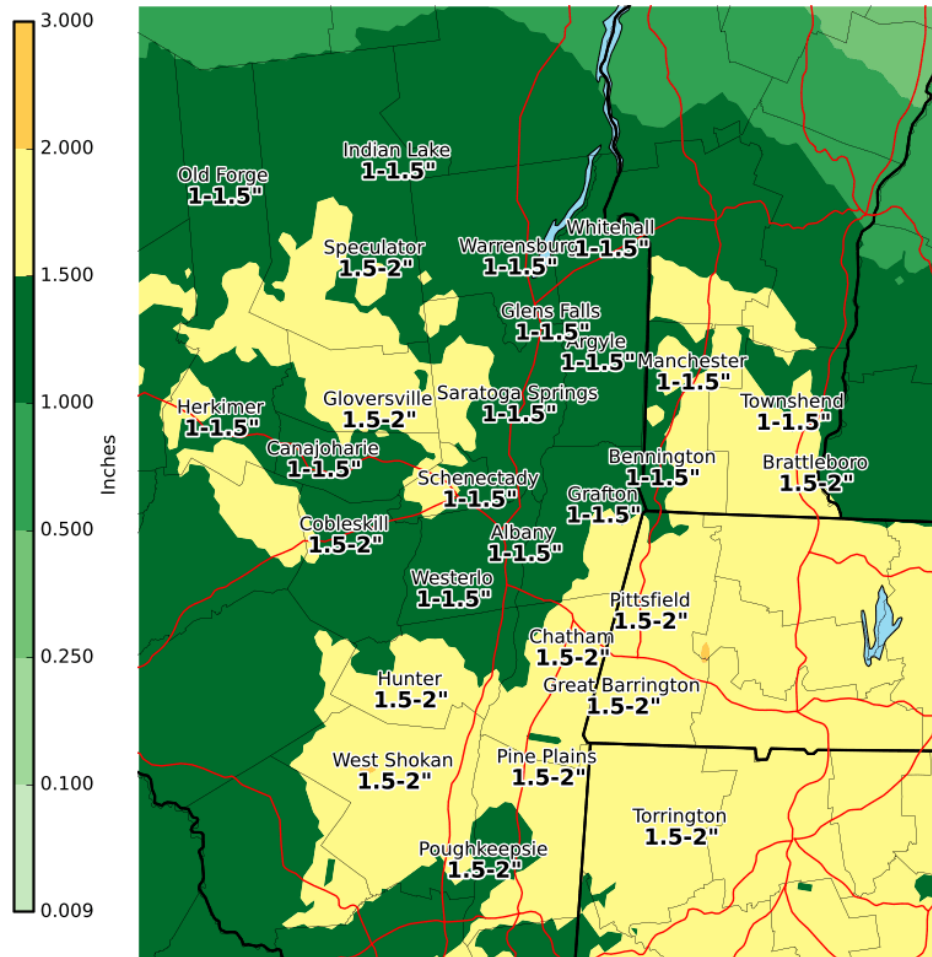

# Event Summary

**Heavy mixed precipitation possible with the main threat Freezing Rain**

- Ice accumulations of one quarter to greater than one half of an inch possible
- Total snow accumulations of up to 2 inches

- ✓ **Impact Period** Sunday Evening into Tuesday Afternoon with the greatest ice accumulations at this time expected overnight Sunday night through Monday morning
- ✓ **Hazardous Travel** through the period with both the morning and evening commutes Monday and the morning commute Tuesday being impacted

**This a complex storm with a lot of precipitation expected so adjustments to ice accumulations and snow/sleet forecasts should be expected**

**The Winter Storm Watch may be expanded to include additional areas later today**

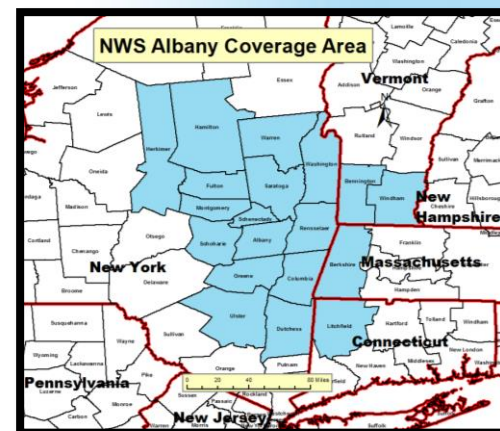
