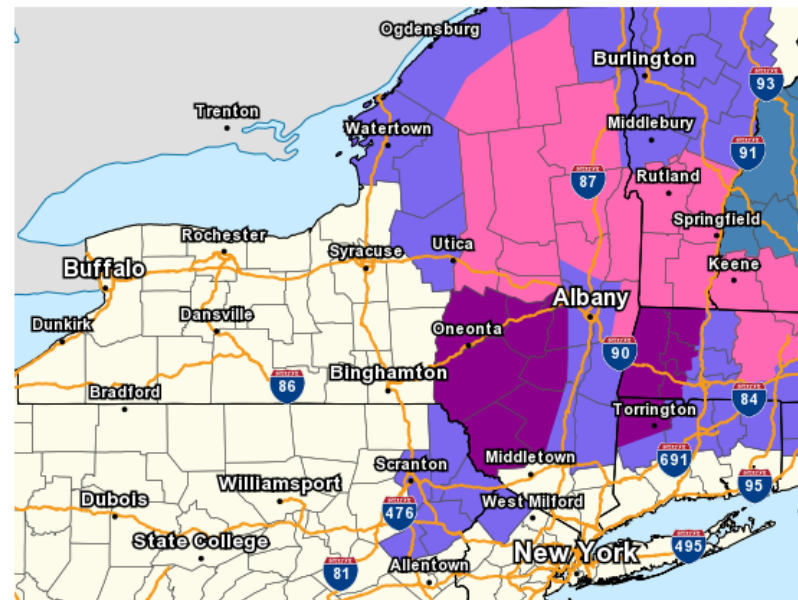
What Has Changed?

- ✓ **Winter Storm Warning:** western/southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Lake George Saratoga Region, Washington County, northern Taconics and southern Vermont
- ✓ **Winter Weather Advisory:** Capital District, mid Hudson Valley, central/southern Taconics and southern Litchfield County

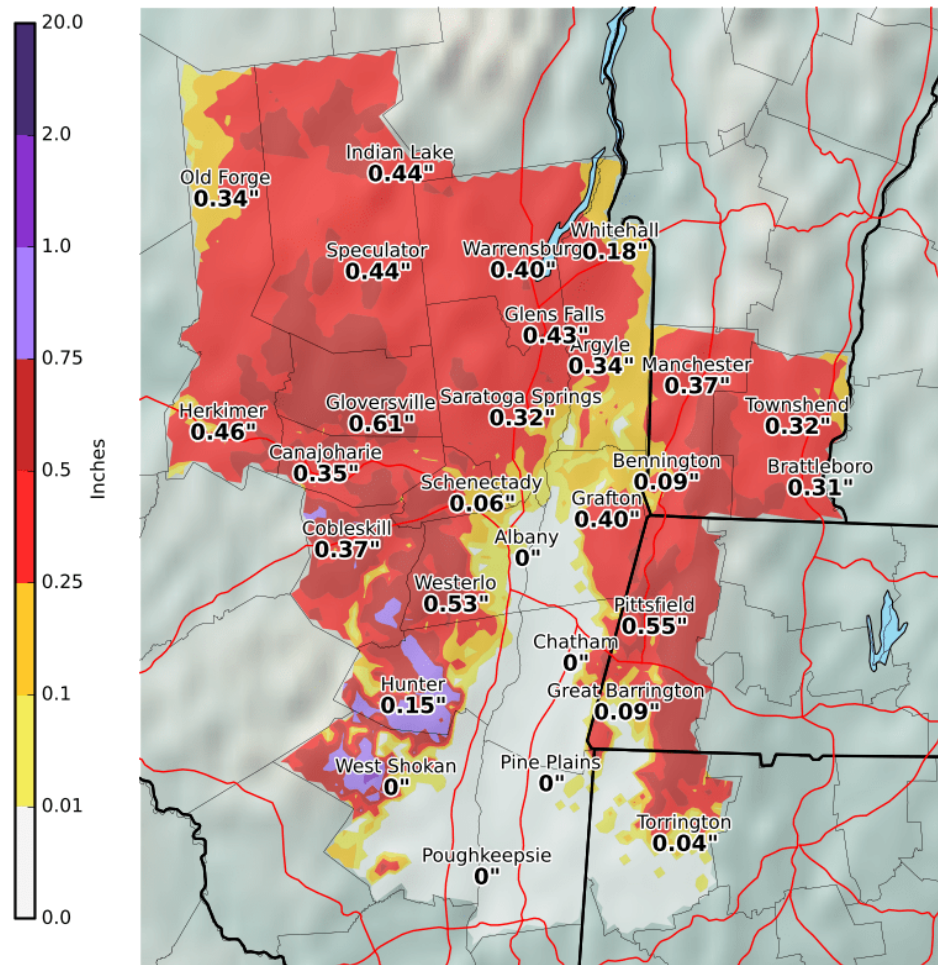

	Some power outages and tree damage are possible due to the ice. Travel could be difficult.	Western & southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Lake George Saratoga Region, Washington County, Taconics Capital District, mid Hudson Valley, southern Litchfield County and southern Vermont	This evening through Monday night
Snow/Sleet 	Any amounts of snow and sleet will to add to the potential for power outages and hazardous travel	Western & southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Lake George Saratoga Region, Washington County, northern Taconics and southern Vermont	This evening and again late Monday into Tuesday

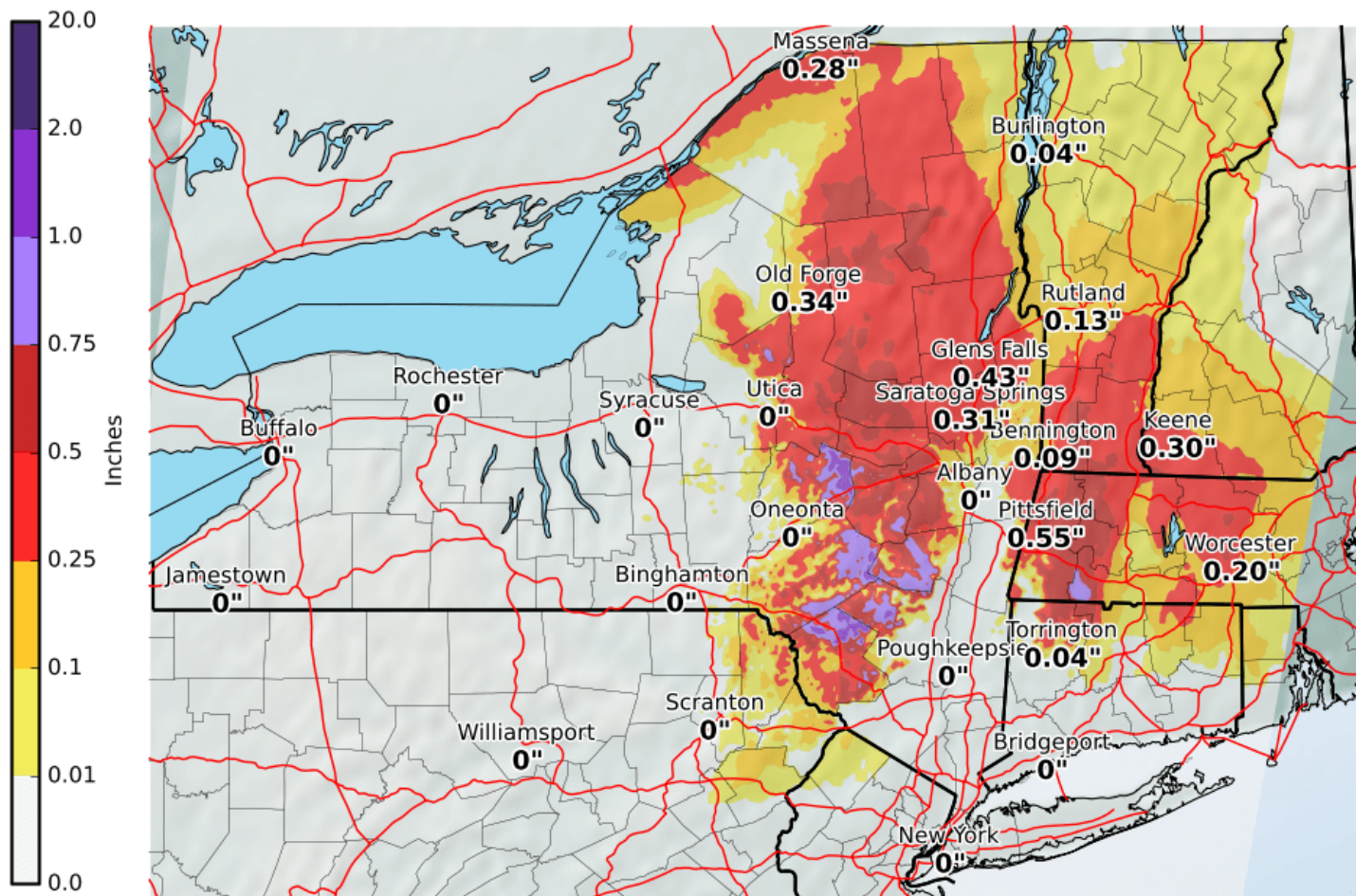

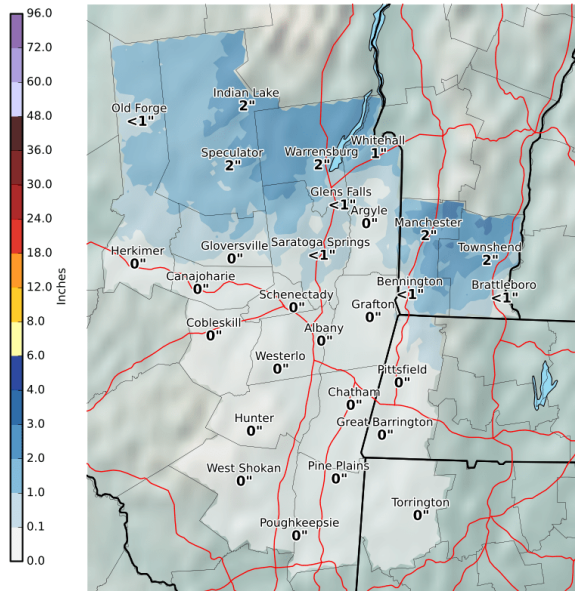

Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

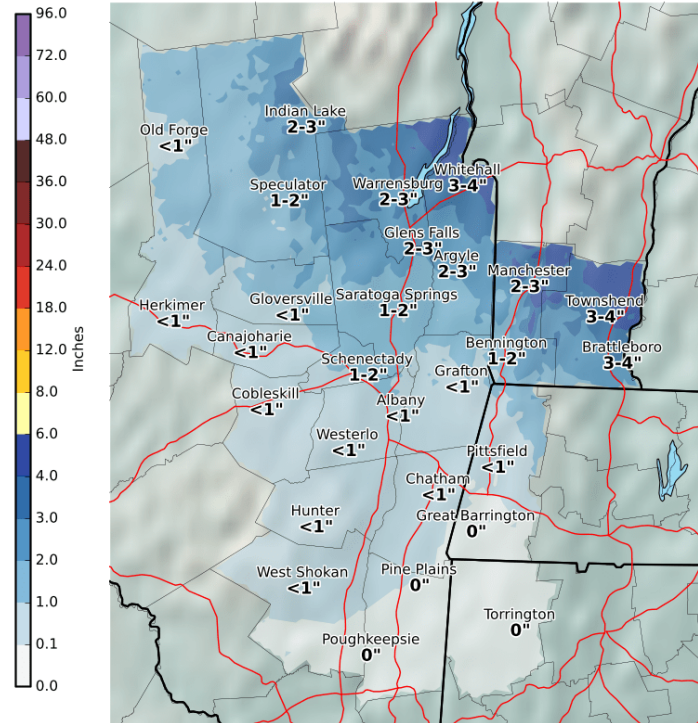

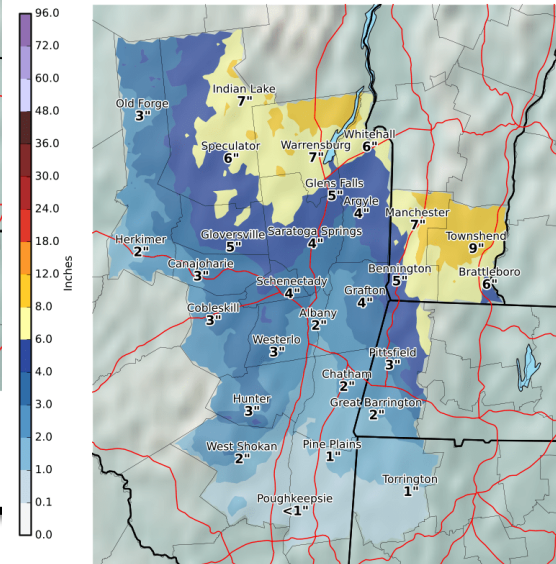


Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast

High End Amount

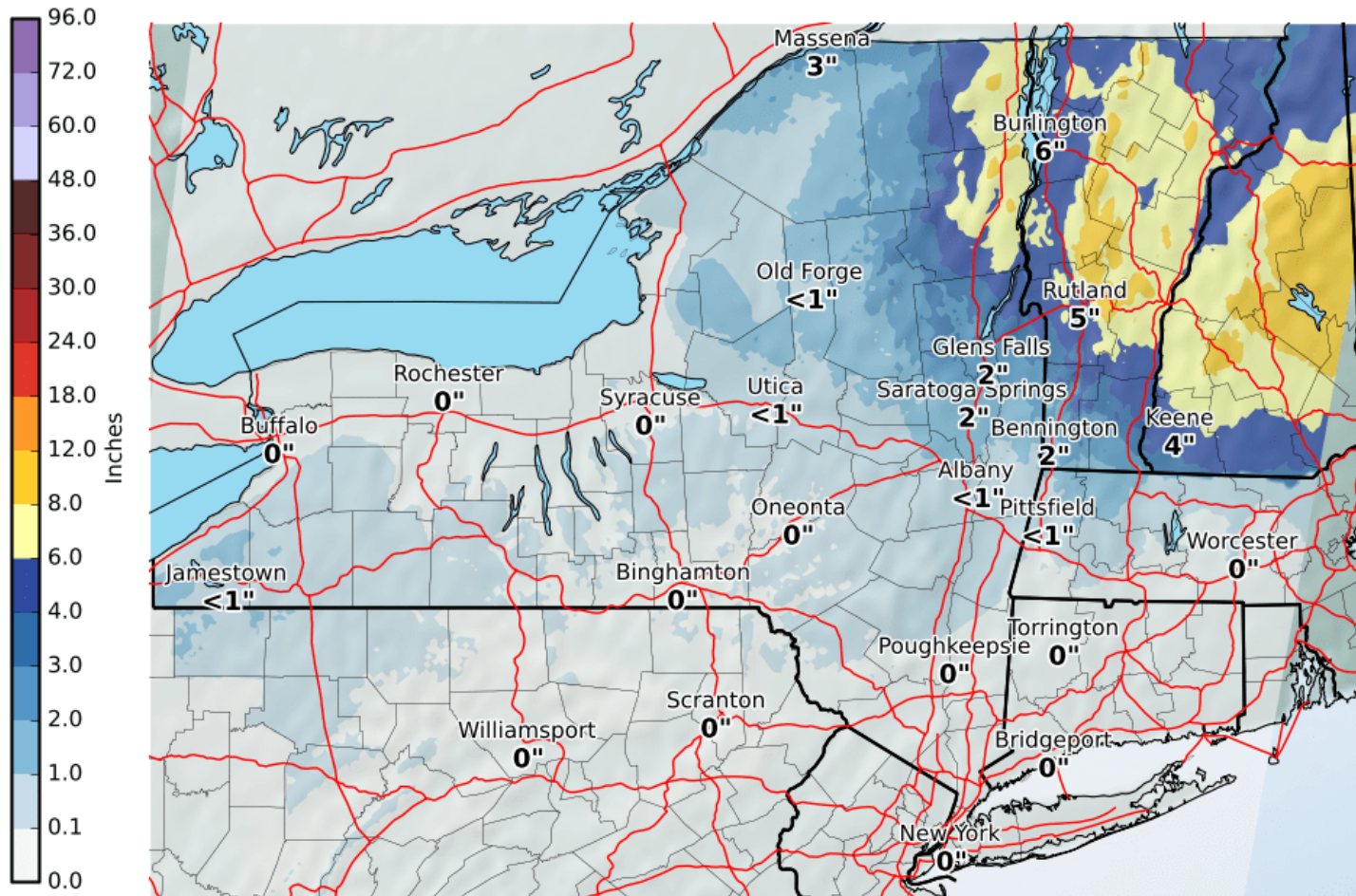
High End Amount - 1 in 10 Chance (10%) Of Higher Snowfall

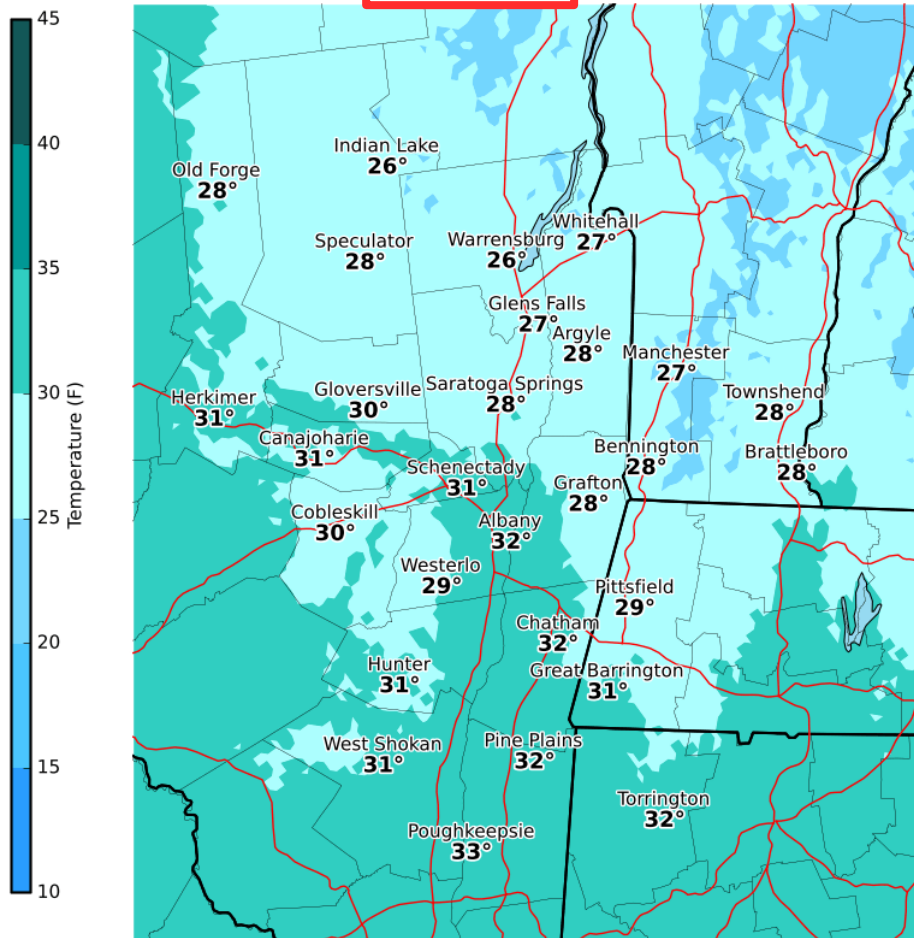

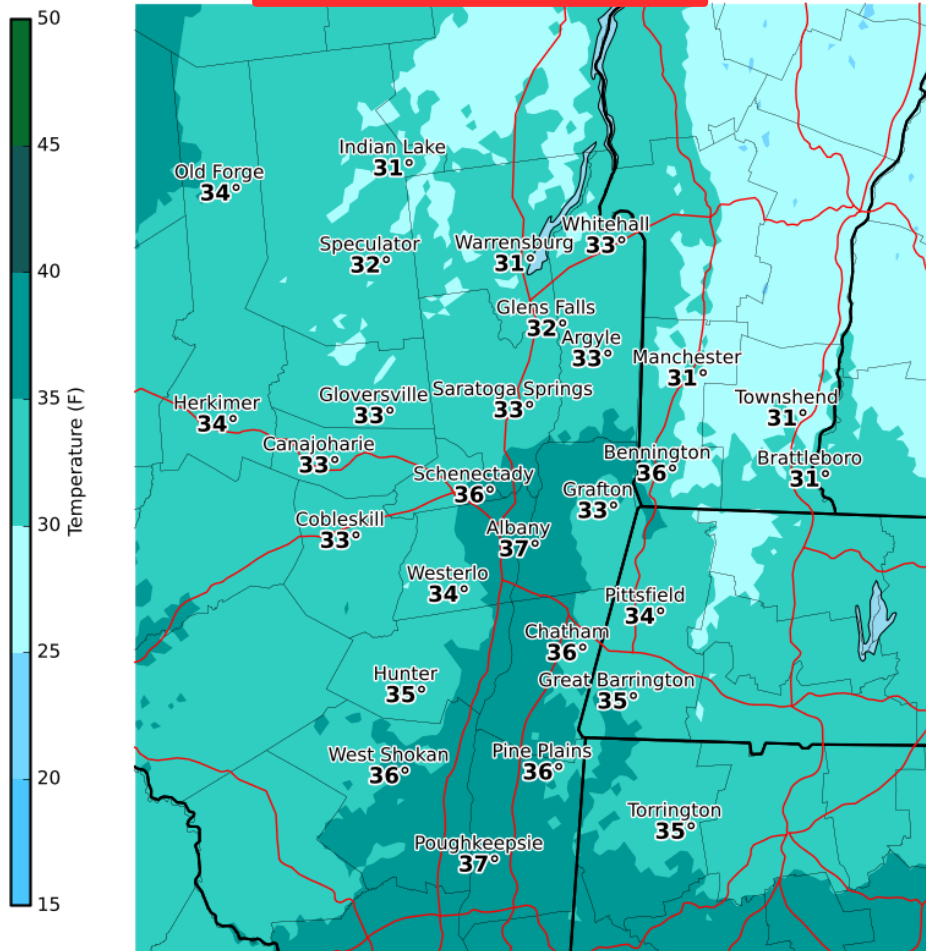

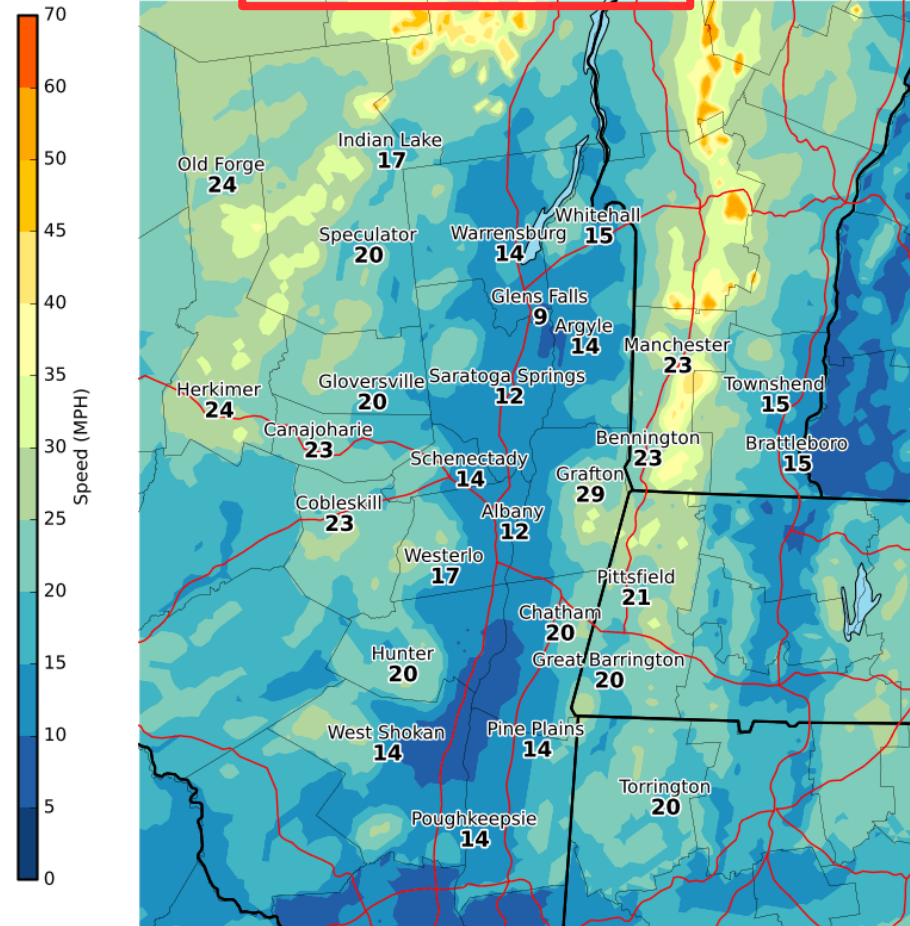
Forecast Peak Wind Gusts

Freezing Rain, Sleet and Snow to impact area this evening into Tuesday with significant icing

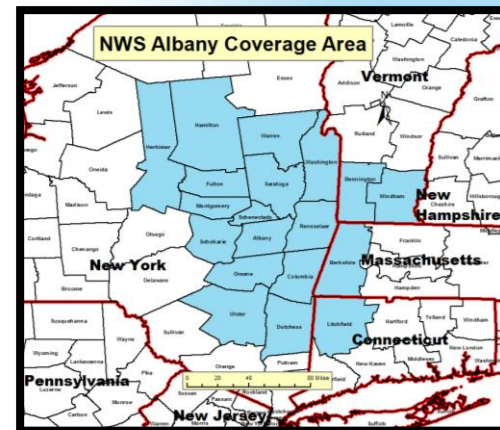
- ✓ **Confidence:** High
