






Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast




Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast



Most likely time frame of winter precipitation


Winter Precipitation Onset Time



Valid Ending Thursday January 2nd, 2020 at 1 PM EST

- Less than an inch
- 1 to 2 inches
- 2 to 3 inches
- 3 to 4 inches
- 4 to 6 inches
- 6 to 8 inches
- 8 to 12 inches
- 12 to 18 inches
- 18 to 24 inches
- 24 to 30 inches
- 30 to 36 inches
- Greater than 36 inches

Event Summary

Freezing Rain

Significant icing has ended. Light additional icing this morning where temperatures below freezing

- ✓ **Impact Period:** Through 10 AM this morning
- ✓ **Additional Ice Accumulations:** A trace to a few hundredths of an inch
- ✓ **Impacts:** Locally Slippery Travel



Event Summary

Snow

Western Adirondacks

- ✓ **Impact Period:** 7 PM Tuesday through 7 PM Wednesday
- ✓ **Snow Accumulations:** 3-7 inches
- ✓ **Impacts:** Difficult Travel Conditions



Snow

Higher Terrain of Southern Vermont

- ✓ **Impact Period:** Tuesday evening
- ✓ **Snow Accumulations:** 1-3 inches
- ✓ **Impacts:** Slippery Travel
