


Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Freezing Rain	Roadways and walkways could become slippery, resulting in hazardous travel conditions	Western/southern Adirondacks and western/central Mohawk Valley	Through early this afternoon
Flooding	Heavy rainfall and snow melt could result in urban/poor drainage flooding and minor river flooding	Western/southern Adirondacks and western/central Mohawk Valley	Tonight through Sunday

Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ A light glaze to less than one tenth of an inch of ice.
- Freezing rain is possible through early this afternoon. Rising temperatures will result in precipitation changing to plain rain this afternoon.






Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast – Through Today



Expected Snowfall







Event Summary – Winter Weather Advisory/Flood Watch

 Confidence is MODERATE that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts

NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE

Period of greatest impact: Through early this afternoon for freezing rain.
Saturday night through Sunday morning for flooding



A light glaze to less than one tenth of an inch of ice is possible through early this afternoon. Roadways and walkways may become slippery, resulting in hazardous travel conditions.



Heavy rainfall combined with snow melt could result in urban/poor drainage flooding and minor river flooding, especially Saturday night into Sunday.
