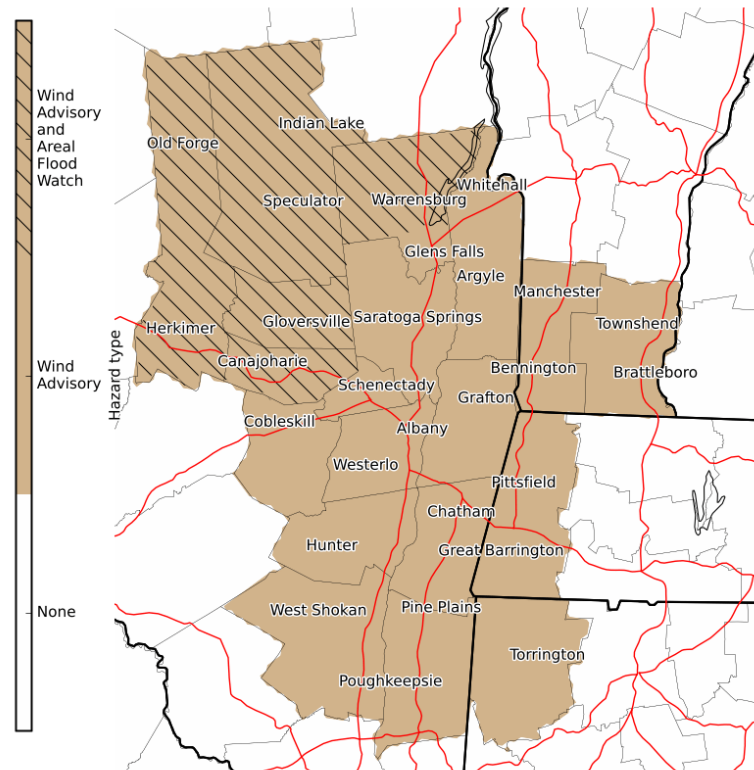

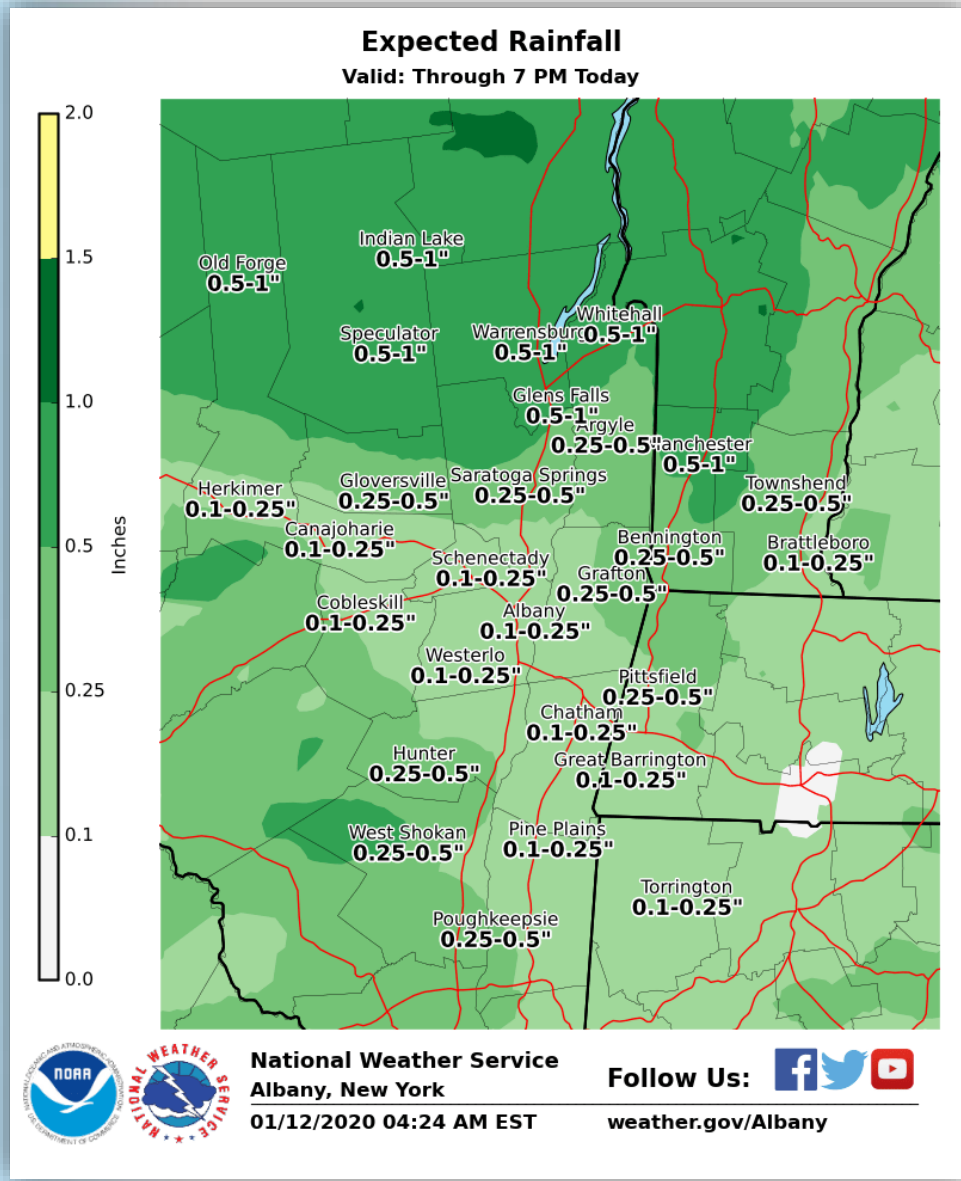

Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Flooding 	<p>The combination of heavy rainfall and snow melt could result in urban/poor drainage flooding and minor river flooding.</p>	<p>Herkimer, Fulton, Montgomery, Hamilton and northern Warren counties</p>	<p>Through 6 PM</p>
Gusty Winds 	<p>Southwest to west winds will gust up to 50 mph. This will cause some downed trees, resulting in power outages.</p>	<p>All of eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>Through this Afternoon</p>
Thunder-Storms 	<p>Isolated thunderstorms ahead of advancing frontal boundary. Gusty winds may accompany any thunderstorm.</p>	<p>All of eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>Early this Morning</p>
Falling Temperatures 	<p>Temperatures will fall through the day today. As temperatures drop below freezing, any wet surfaces may become slick quickly.</p>	<p>All of eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>This Afternoon through this Evening</p>

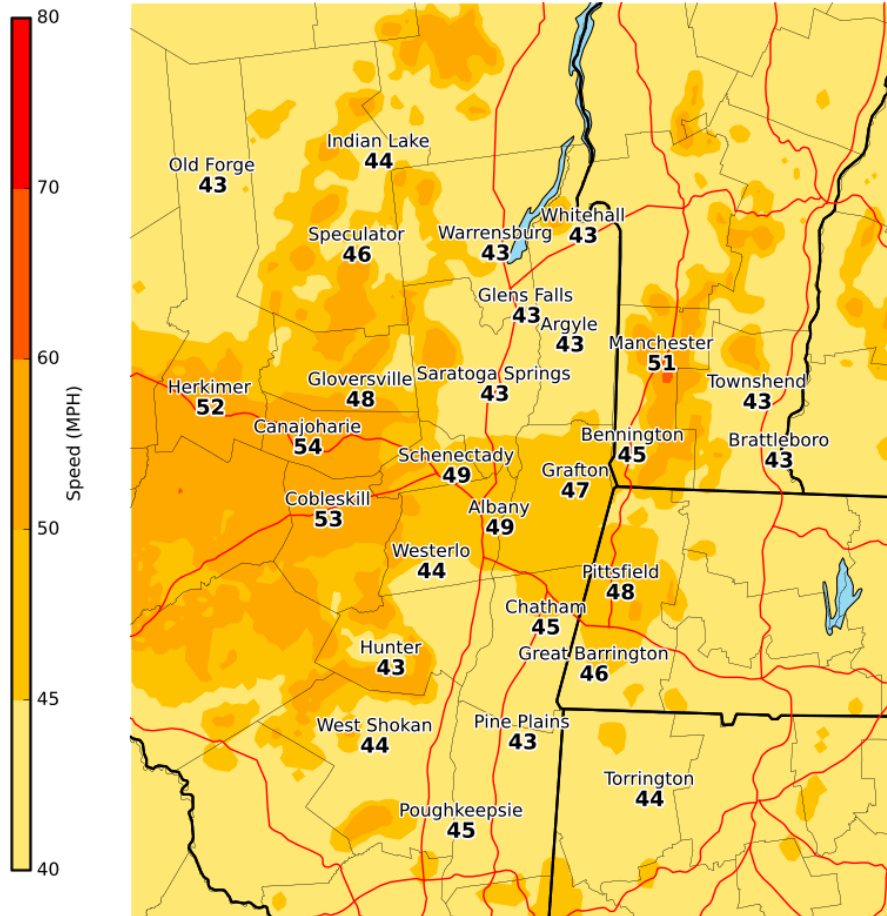




Moderate rises are expected on rivers and streams due to a combination of rainfall and snowmelt. The largest river rises will be across the Adirondacks. Minor river flooding cannot be ruled out. Ponding of water is also expected in urban and low lying areas.

Highest Expected Wind Gusts

Valid: Through 7 PM Today



South winds will become southwest to west today and reach 40 to 55 mph across the entire region. These winds may cause some downed trees and tree limbs, resulting in power outages. Winds will diminish this evening.

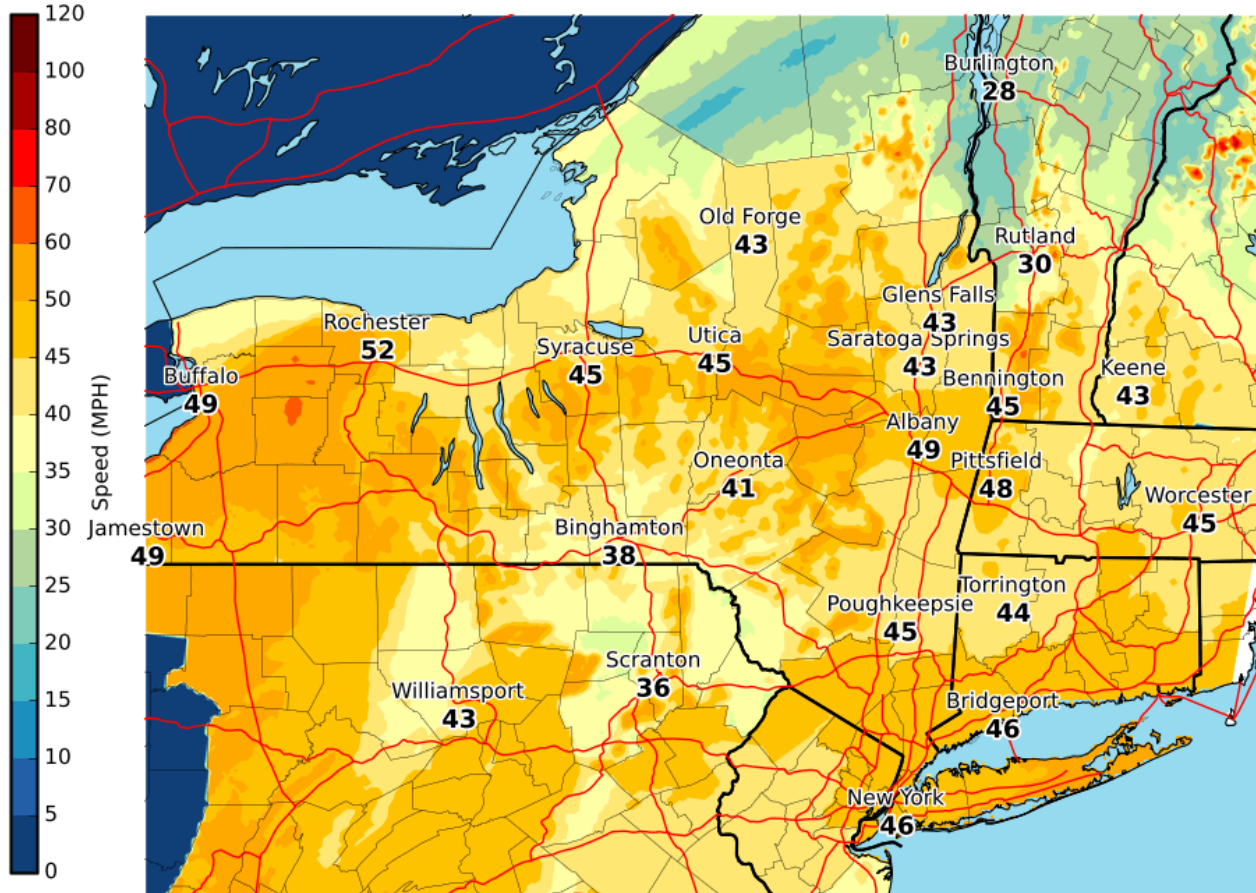

Event Summary – Wind Advisory & Flood Watch

- ✓ Period of greatest impact:
 - ✓ Through this morning for heavy rainfall and thunderstorm potential
 - ✓ Through this afternoon for gusty winds



Heavy rainfall combined with snow melt could result in urban/poor drainage flooding this morning and minor river flooding.



Gusty winds to 55 mph will result in some downed trees & limbs, allowing for some power outages.



Some thunderstorms possible early this morning. Gusty winds may accompany any thunderstorm.

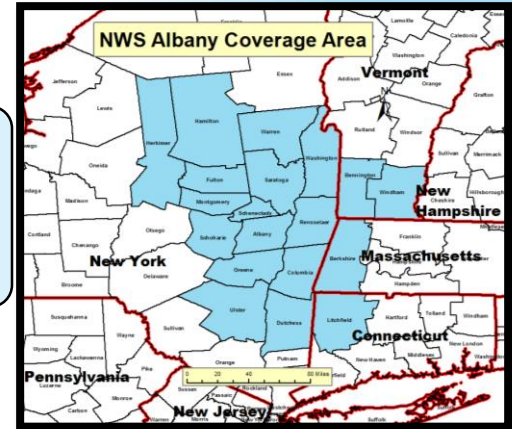


Falling temperatures this afternoon into this evening. Temperatures falling below freezing may allow wet surfaces to become slick.
