Strong-Damaging Winds



Loose objects will become airborne; scattered tree damage, isolated power outages, possible structure damage

water rescues. Some minor river flooding possible.

Scattered areas of beach erosion and coastal flooding

Primarily eastern
Massachusetts and Rhode
Island. Strongest Winds Cape
Cod/Islands.

Primarily the south coast of Rhode Island and Massachusetts

Especially the Friday late afternoon/evening tide.

Evening.
















### Forecast Storm Total Precipitation








#### Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts

## Max Wind Gusts (MPH) Valid: Peaking Mid Day Friday Into Friday Evening














## Coastal Flooding – Surge / Inundation

#### **Minor Coastal Flooding**

- Partial inundation within the flood zone, especially for low-lying areas.
- Vulnerable shore roads with up to a foot of water inundation possible. May be flooding of a few vulnerable basements.
- Some beach erosion with heavy surf.

#### **Timing**

Mainly around the late Friday hight tide cycle.

	Storm Surge Threat	Potential Impacts from Storm Surge
Little to None	0 to 1 feet above ground	No immediate preparations needed. Little to no potential storm surge flooding impacts
Elevated	1 to 3 feet above ground	To be safe, prepare for the potential of limited storm surge flooding impacts
Moderate	3 to 6 feet above ground	To be safe, earnestly prepare for the potential of significant storm surge flooding impacts
High	6 to 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of significant storm surge flooding impacts
Extreme	> 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of devastating to catastrophic storm surge flooding impacts

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## **Threat Event Summary**

- ✓ <u>Confidence</u>: Generally High for that there will be impacts. Lower confidence on timing and exact locations of each impact.
- ✓ What:



Some stream and river flooding possible, which may linger into the weekend. Street and poor drainage flooding likely.



Strong winds gusting 50-60 mph along the southeast coast. 40-50 mph inland.



Some minor coastal flooding with the late day high tide Friday on the south coast.

- ✓ Where: All of Southern New England will experience some impact.
- ✓ When: Early Friday morning into Friday evening. Impacts to both commutes.


