





What Has Changed?

- High Wind Warnings and Wind Advisories for RI/E MA
- Storm Warnings for most of MA coastal waters
- Coastal Flood Advisory for South Coastal MA/RI
- Focus for heaviest rainfall now in western/central MA & northern CT









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Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Urban Flooding	Impacts to both rush hours and early holiday travel. Flooding of roads that typically flood in heavy rain, some may be closed	All of Southern New England	Early Friday Morning Into Friday Night
River Flooding	Minor flooding Moderate flooding possible along faster-responding rivers	All of Southern New England, especially Connecticut River basin	Friday afternoon into Sunday
Damaging Winds	Damage to trees and power lines; scattered power outages	Southeast Massachusetts and Rhode Island. Strongest Winds on Cape Cod and the Islands.	Friday Morning Into Friday Evening.
Coastal Flooding	Minor. Up to 1 foot of inundation on vulnerable shore roads; most shore roads remain open and passable. Minor beach erosion.	South Coastal Rhode Island and Massachusetts	Friday evening high tide (6:56 PM in Providence)



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
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






Wind Related Hazards

Flooding Hazards



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


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
Forecast Storm Total Precipitation







Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts








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Coastal Flooding – Surge / Inundation

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Minor Coastal Flooding

- Up to 1 foot of inundation on vulnerable shore roads
- Most shore roads remain open and passable
- Minor beach erosion with heavy surf

Timing

- Possibly during early Friday morning high tide
- More likely with late Friday afternoon/evening high tide

	Little to None	0 to 1 feet above ground	No immediate preparations needed. Little to no potential storm surge flooding impacts	
	Elevated	1 to 3 feet above ground	To be safe, prepare for the potential of limited storm surge flooding impacts	
	Moderate	3 to 6 feet above ground	To be safe, earnestly prepare for the potential of significant storm surge flooding impacts	
	High	6 to 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of significant storm surge flooding impacts	
	Extreme	> 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of devastating to catastrophic storm surge flooding impacts	
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




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Coastal Flooding – East Coast Surge / Inundation

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Minor Coastal Flooding

- Pockets of inundation of up to 1 foot on vulnerable shore roads (Morrissey Blvd in Boston)
- Most shore roads remain open and passable
- Minor beach erosion with heavy surf

Early Friday morning high tide


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	Extreme	> 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of devastating to catastrophic storm surge flooding impacts

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Threat Event Summary

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✓ Confidence: High.

What:



Urban flooding, especially on roads that typically flood. Minor river flooding, perhaps moderate flooding on faster-responding rivers.



Damaging wind gusts of 40-60 mph, highest near the South Coast, Cape Cod, and the Islands.



Minor coastal flooding with the late day high tide Friday on the South Coast, but possibly early Friday morning in vulnerable East Coast locations.

- Where: All of Southern New England will experience some impact.
- ✓ When: Early Friday morning into Friday evening. Impacts to both commutes and early holiday travel.




