### Hurricane Dorian

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing	
Wind	There is a risk for scattered wind damage	Cape Cod and the Islands	Late Friday night into Saturday morning	
Storm Surge/ Inundation	There is the potential for minor inundation in spots	Nantucket Harbor	Saturday morning	
Flooding Rain	There is the potential for significant rainfall that could lead to areas or urban and poor drainage flooding	Cape Cod and the Islands	Late Friday night into Saturday morning	
Tornado	No risk from tornadoes			
Marine	There is the potential for very dangerous conditions	Mainly across the waters east of Cape Cod and south and east of Nantucket	Late Friday night into Saturday morning	

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






### Situation Overview

#### Hurricane Dorian



**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

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- A Tropical Storm Watch has been issued for Cape Cod and the Islands
- Wind impacts, including downed trees and power lines leading to scattered power outages.
- Heavy rainfall causing areas of urban and poor drainage flooding

- Minor coastal flooding for Nantucket Harbor
- High surf and dangerous rip currents














# **TSWind Speed Probabilities**


- Greatest risk for tropical storm force winds across Nantucket and the outer Cape
- Strongest winds will be late Friday night into Saturday morning





# Most Likely Time of Arrival

### Hurricane Dorian



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
- The most likely time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds for the Cape and Islands is after midnight Friday night into Saturday morning
- However, this area could see Tropical Storm Force Winds as early as Friday evening

  Saturday morning


