Flooding Rain		There is the potential for heavy rainfall that could lead to flash flooding	Western Massachusetts and western Connecticut, especially The Berkshires.	This afternoon and tonight
Tornado		There is a threat for a few tornadoes.	All of southern New England.	This afternoon and evening
Marine		There is the potential for dangerous conditions. High rip current risk on the south coast.	All coastal and nearshore waters.	Today and Wednesday





New Information

 Increased threat for a few tornadoes this afternoon and evening.


Concerns

- Strong winds, sustained 25-35 mph with gusts 40-50 mph. Low risk of 60 mph gusts. Could lead to downed trees and power outages.
- Heavy rain, I-3" totals with localized 4" possible in Western MA and Northern CT, especially over the Berkshires.
- Threat for a few tornadoes across southern New England.
- Dangerous rip currents and minor coastal flooding, especially for South-facing beaches.

Tropical Storm Isaias






The most likely time that tropical storm force winds begin is mid to lateafternoon today.




- Storm Total rainfall forecast valid Tuesday Morning through Wednesday Night.


Strong wind gusts expected, especially over western/central Massachusetts and northern Connecticut

Rainfall flooding possible, mainly across western Massachusetts and western Connecticut




Threat for a few tornadoes during this afternoon and evening
