


## OVERVIEW:

- Significant Rainfall, especially late Thu into Thu Night.
- Some snow likely mixes in after midnight Fri, especially across the high terrain of central and western MA.
- Light snow accumulations possible

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Mainly late Thursday into Thursday Night.</li> <li>▪ All of southern New England</li> </ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Ponding of water in poor-drainage and urban areas, especially if drains are leaf-clogged.</li> <li>▪ A slippery Friday morning commute across the higher terrain, where snow develops. 1 to 3 inches is possible.</li> <li>▪ Gusty NE winds could lead to isolated tree and power line damage.</li> </ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ No winter headlines at this time. Will be considered with later forecasts. A Gale Warning will be in effect over most of the coastal Thu night - Fri. Small Craft Advisories for Boston Harbor and Narragansett Bay.</li> </ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Timing. We are confident the storm will track to our south. Much easier to accumulate snow at night than during the day.</li> </ul>	
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ We will get a better handle on the timing within the next 24 hours</li> </ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Sharply colder Friday and Friday night</li> </ul>
