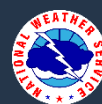


Wet Weather Thu Into Fri

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Significant Rainfall, especially late Thu into Thu Night.
- Some snow likely mixes in after midnight Fri, especially across the high terrain of central and western MA.
- Light snow accumulations possible

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Mainly late Thursday into Thursday Night.▪ All of southern New England
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Ponding of water in poor-drainage and urban areas, especially if drains are leaf-clogged.▪ A slippery Friday morning commute across the higher terrain, where snow develops. 1 to 3 inches is possible.▪ Gusty NE winds could lead to isolated tree and power line damage.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ No winter headlines at this time. Will be considered with later forecasts. A Gale Watch is in effect over the waters for strong winds Thu night – Fri.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Timing. We are confident the storm will track to our south. Much easier to accumulate snow at night than during the day.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ We will get a better handle on the timing within the next 24 hours

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Sharply colder Friday and Friday night
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 6 PM Wednesday
