


## OVERVIEW:

- Rain changing to snow after midnight, especially across the high terrain of central and western MA.
- Rain changing to snow along the I-95 corridor Friday morning
- Light snow accumulations possible

<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A slippery Friday morning commute across the interior, where snow develops. 1 to 3 inches is possible.</li> <li>▪ Gusty NE winds could lead to isolated tree and power line damage.</li> </ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ No winter headlines at this time. A Wind Advisory has been issued for the Cape and Islands tonight into Friday.</li> </ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Extent of accumulating snow in the I-95 corridor Friday morning is the biggest challenge.</li> </ul>	
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Total rainfall amounts of 1-2 inches are expected.</li> </ul>
