- Snowfall totals of 1-3 inches expected.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Late tonight through Friday morning. ▪ Winter weather threat for the interior and I-95 corridor. ▪ Heaviest snowfall from 5 AM-12 PM. ▪ Precipitation ending during the afternoon. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A slippery Friday morning commute across much of the interior extending into the I-95 corridor - especially on secondary roads and untreated surfaces. ▪ Gusty NE winds could lead to isolated tree and power line damage. 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisory for the interior late tonight into Friday morning. ▪ Wind Advisory for the Cape and Islands tonight into Friday. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ If the 3 inch amounts are more widespread then there may be isolated power outages.
