

# Strong winds Sunday Evening



## OVERVIEW:

- Strong cold front moves across the area Sunday evening & overnight
- The front will be accompanied by strong southerly winds
- The winds may be strong enough to produce tree damage & isolated power outages, especially if a line of showers & T-storms develop

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ Strongest wind & heaviest rain from 6 pm to 2 am from west to east	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	▪ Strong southerly winds may result in tree damage & isolated power outages	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ Wind advisories in effect for all of RI and eastern MA for Sunday evening	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	▪ Potentially three brief rounds of strong winds, 1) south winds ahead of the cold front, 2) line of showers & isolated thunderstorms along the front and then 3) strong west winds immediately behind the front. Uncertainty on areal coverage of strong winds. If a line of heavy showers & thunderstorms develop, the risk for strong winds increase.	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	▪ Winds slowly subside overnight Sunday into Monday.	 <p><b>Strong Winds Sunday and Sunday Night</b> Damage To Trees And Power Lines Are Possible.
