- Strong cold front moves across the area Sunday evening & overnight
- The front will be accompanied by strong southerly winds
- The winds may be strong enough to produce tree damage & isolated power outages, especially if a line of showers & T-storms develop

Potentially three brief rounds of strong winds, I) south winds ahead of the cold front, 2) line of showers & isolated thunderstorms along the front and then 3) strong west winds immediately behind the front. Uncertainty on areal coverage of strong winds. If a line of heavy showers & thunderstorms develop, the risk for strong winds increase.
