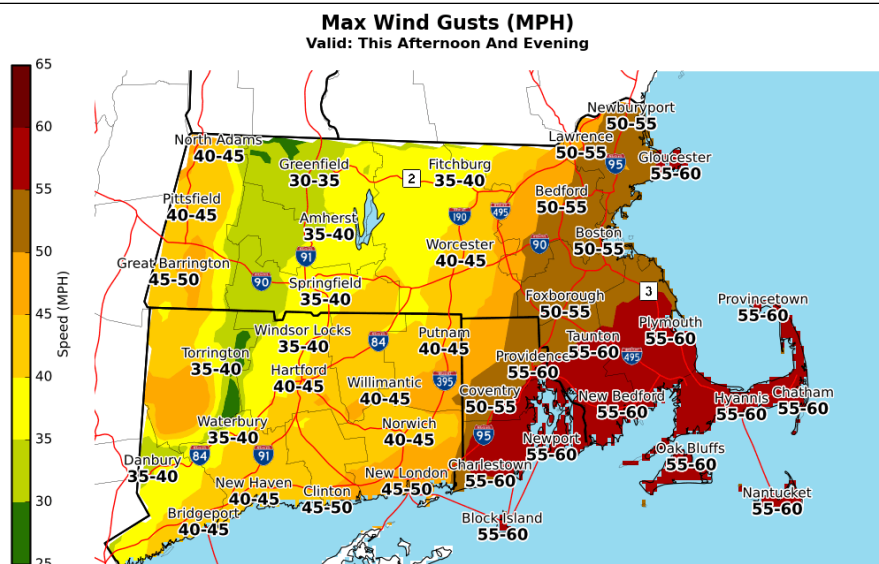

## OVERVIEW:

- Strong to Damaging winds this afternoon and evening
- Strongest Winds Across Eastern MA & RI
- Heavy rain may result in street/highway flooding

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Strongest wind from 3 PM through midnight.</li><li>▪ Heaviest rain this afternoon and evening.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Damaging wind gusts may result in at least isolated power outages especially in RI/SE MA.</li><li>▪ Heavy rain likely impacts the evening commute with street flooding possible.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Wind Advisory N. CT, NW RI &amp; Interior into NE MA.</li><li>▪ High Wind Warning Central and Southern RI, as well as Southeast MA and coastal Essex County.</li></ul>
<b>Forecast Challenges</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Areal extent of 60 mph winds, are they isolated or more widespread?</li></ul>
