



## OVERVIEW:

There is increasing potential for an impactful storm this weekend, with heavy rain/strong winds along the coast Sat into Sat night and rain changing over to accumulating snow over the high terrain. However, snow could develop all the way to the coast depending on the storm track. There remains considerable forecast uncertainty at this time given the complexity of the potential system.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Saturday into early Sunday.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Accumulating snow especially across interior high terrain, although snow could develop all the way to the coast.</li><li>▪ Widespread 1-2 inches of rain, with heavier amounts expected across RI and southeast MA.</li><li>▪ Strong winds along the coast; gales and very rough seas coastal waters</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Track of the storm remains uncertain, which could have significant implications for the location, amount, and type of precipitation, as well as the wind direction over the coastal waters.</li></ul>
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Stay tuned for additional information as the event draws nearer and the forecast confidence increases.</li></ul>
