OVERVIEW:

- Black ice & freezing fog is likely tonight & early Monday morning, resulting in slippery travel

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">As temperatures cool Sunday evening, black ice & freezing fog will form especially overnight into early Monday morning.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Widespread black ice and freezing fog will result in slippery travel Sunday night into early Monday morning, the only exception will be across Cape Cod and the Islands where temperatures will remain above freezing.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Exact timing of the onset of black ice & freezing fog, however becoming increasing likely as the night progresses into Monday morning.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Untreated surfaces will become very slippery.
