Dense Fog



Visibility possibly lowering to less than a quarter mile at times

All areas but greatest risk across CT into Western-Central MA where deepest snowpack exist

Christmas Eve night into Christmas morning

South coast of MA and RI

Friday morning high tide (around 4 AM)

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






Forecast Maximum Sustained Winds

Valid: Thursday Night and Friday












Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts






Forecast Storm Total Precipitation









Forecast Maximum Wave Heights and Wind Gusts (in kts)

Threat Event Summary

✓ Confidence: moderate confidence on a high impact weather event

✓ What:



25-40 mph sustained winds with gusts up to 65 mph, resulting in a risk for scattered power outages.



1.5 to 2.5 inches of rainfall with locally higher amounts up to 3 inches is possible. Minor river flooding & street & highway flooding



Areas of dense fog possible with visibility reduced to a quarter mile or less at times. Potential travel impacts.




Minor coastal flooding possible along the south coast of MA & RI.

✓ Where: All of Southern New England (MA, RI & CT)

✓ When: Christmas Eve night into Christmas morning


