

Two Light Wintry Mix Events

OVERVIEW:

- First event will feature light freezing rain, possible mixed with a little snow or sleet overnight limited to the Berkshires and NW CT
- Second event will be more widespread Friday night and Saturday morning. Starts as light snow, transitions to a wintry mix then to plain rain.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">First event - overnight across the Berkshires and NW CTSecond Event - starts Friday night, continues to Saturday morning.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">For both events, only expected impacts will be to travel related activities. Light glaze of ice will make untreated roads and sidewalks slippery
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">For tonight, Icing conditions may be more spotty than the forecast shows due to marginal temperatures and light precipitationFor Friday night and Saturday, timing of changeover from light snow to sleet to freezing rain will dictate how much snow vs ice
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Tonight - Winter Weather Advisory for Berkshires and NW CTFriday Night & Saturday - None at this time.

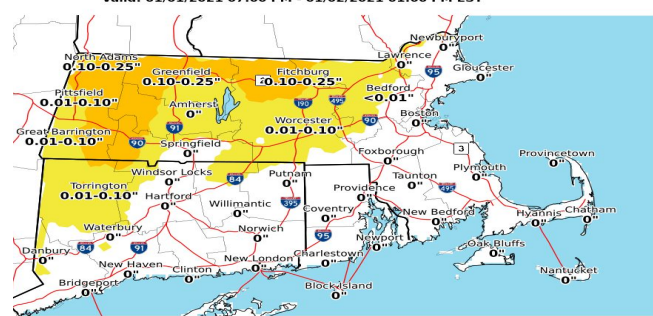
