

Light Wintry Mix In Berkshires



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- A period of light snow, sleet and freezing rain is expected in the Berkshires tonight. A dusting to up to 1 inch of snow along with a light glaze of ice are possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The Light Wintry mix should develop in the Berkshires between 7 and 11 pm this evening and come to an end by daybreak Thursday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Untreated roads and walkways may become slippery.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Outside of the Berkshires, precipitation should be in the form of light rain tonight. The exception to this might be the northern Worcester Hills, where slippery travel is possible if temperatures stay cold enough.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Untreated surfaces will become slippery.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Temps rise above freezing Thursday morning. Another light wintry mix is expected Friday night, but this will impact most areas away from the coast.
