

OVERVIEW:

- A Wintry mix is expected Friday night into early Saturday morning northwest of the Boston to Providence corridor. Precipitation type should initially be sleet and freezing rain, but a brief period of snow is possible in northern MA at the onset. Most locales should change to rain Saturday morning, except for the highest terrain in MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Precipitation arrives between 6 and 10 PM Friday evening with most of it coming to an end by Saturday afternoon.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Untreated roads will become slippery from a light glaze of ice, but not enough to result in tree damage. 1 to 2 inches of snow is possible across far northern MA, mainly north of Route 2.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Whether there a period of snow at the onset in northern MA or precipitation is mainly just in the form of sleet and freezing rain. How widespread light icing will be in the lower elevations or will it be mainly in the higher terrain of the Berkshires and Worcester Hills.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are no Current Winter Weather Headlines In Effect. Winter Weather Advisories will likely be needed for portions of the region Friday night into Saturday morning northwest of the I-95 Corridor.
