

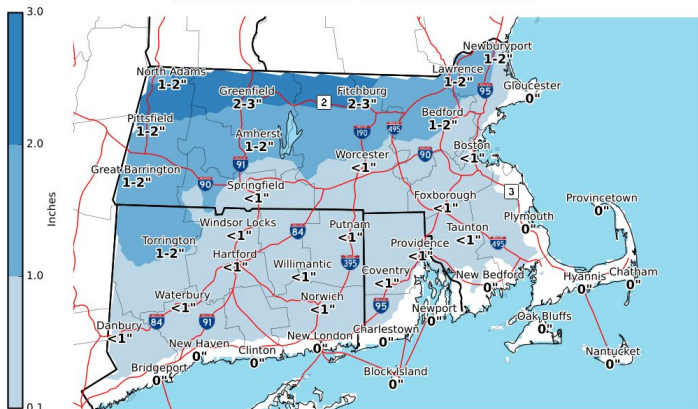
OVERVIEW:

- A Wintry mix is expected tonight into early Saturday morning north and west of the Boston to Providence corridor.
- Precipitation may start as a brief period of snow, but transition to sleet and freezing rain before turning to plain rain.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Precipitation arrives tonight between 7pm and 11pm. Rain will end by Saturday afternoon if not a bit earlier.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Untreated roads will become slippery from a light glaze of ice and sleet. ▪ 1-2 inches of snow is also possible across portions of northern MA. ▪ The light icing is not expected to cause any tree damage.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Whether 1-2 inches of snow occurs across interior northern MA or if precipitation starts as mainly sleet and freezing rain. ▪ Whether widespread slippery travel is just in the higher terrain of MA or if it impacts the Connecticut River Valley and lowest elevations too.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for all but coastal CT, and in MA, all of western, central areas and eastern MA mainly outside of I-95
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ By 5 PM This Evening

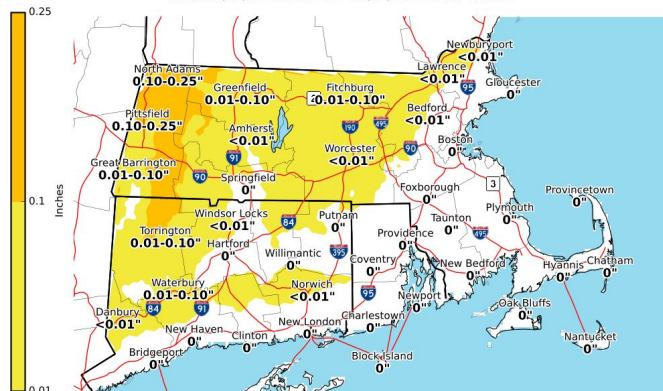
