

OVERVIEW:

- Potential for accumulating snow late Sun into Mon across the interior with mainly rain in the Boston-Providence corridor.
- Main concerns are travel impacts and potential for power outages with heavy, wet snow.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Precipitation moves in from west to east by Sunday late afternoon, becoming widespread overnight. Precipitation should taper off by Mon afternoon, but scattered rain/snow showers could linger through Tue.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ As this will be a heavy, wet snow, the risk of scattered power outages will increase for amounts of 4 inches or greater. ▪ Travel impacts are also expected with snow covered roads.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ We are most confident in the potential for accumulating snow across the interior MA and northern CT. ▪ However, it may be possible that the rain across Eastern MA and RI could end as a period of snow late Mon into Tue but confidence is low.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None but expect winter headlines to be posted sometime this weekend. ▪ A preliminary snowfall map is posted below.
