



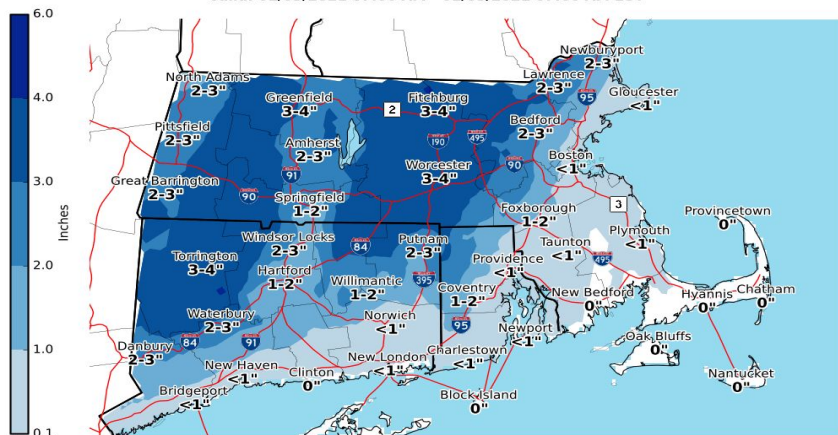
OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating wet snow expected Sunday night into Monday northwest of the I-95 corridor. Along and southeast of the Boston to Providence corridor, rain is expected but that may end as snow.
- Main concerns are travel impacts Sunday night and particularly the Monday morning rush hour. Isolated power outages are possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Precipitation moves in from west to east late Sun afternoon becoming widespread overnight. Precipitation should taper off by Mon afternoon.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 2 to 4 inches of wet snow expected NW of I-95. Localized up to 6" in the terrain. ▪ Travel impacts are expected with snow covered roads. ▪ Isolated power outages are possible if higher snow amounts are realized (over 4").
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ We are confident in accumulating snow northwest of I-95. ▪ Greatest uncertainty is if rain changes to accumulating wet snow in the Boston to Providence corridor or it ends up being an all rain event. ▪ Isolated power outages possible if higher snowfall amounts realized (over 4").
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisory for all of CT, western/central MA east into western Middlesex and western Essex in MA. [1 PM Sun - 7 AM Mon]
