- Areas of black ice overnight as leftover road moisture from light rain Thursday combines with temperatures falling below freezing overnight into Friday morning.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Areas of black ice will result in slippery travel especially on secondary roads, bridges and overpasses. 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Special Weather Statement has been issued to increase public awareness regarding icy roads overnight into the Friday morning commute. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> How quickly temperatures fall below freezing and will subfreezing temperatures make it to the south coast of MA & RI. 	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Emergency Managers - please forward this message to DOT and DPW. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperatures are expected to rise above freezing by 9 or 10 am Friday. Therefore ending the threat of black ice.
