WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Light to moderate snow expected
- In the highest elevations of western MA and CT total snow accumulations of 2 to 3 inches are most likely
- Elsewhere 1 to 2 inches is expected

TIMING	▪ Snow moves in Tuesday evening, continues overnight into Wednesday morning, tapering off in the afternoon	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Hazardous road conditions may result	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Winter Weather Advisory in effect for western MA and CT from 1 PM Tuesday through 10 AM Wednesday	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Low probability that areas along the south coast of CT may experience some mixed precipitation with possible light icing.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	▪ While snow amounts may total 2 to 3 inches or more, it will be over a 12 to 18 hour period.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Light snow eastern MA Thu▪ Frigid temps & gusty winds Thu nite/Fri will lead to freezing spray on the waters
