



What Has Changed?

- ✓ Winter Weather Advisory for Cape Cod & Nantucket
- ✓ Wind Chill Advisory for much of interior MA/CT
- ✓ Heavy Freezing Spray
 Warning for most waters
- ✓ Gale Warning for all waters











Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Snow & Wind	Hazardous travel and localized blizzard conditions possible	Greatest risk from Provincetown to Chatham and possibly on Nantucket	Today and This Evening, greatest risk during the afternoon
Wind Chill	Frostbite on exposed skin in less than 30 minutes	Interior Massachusetts and Connecticut	Until Noon
Freezing Spray	Significant ice accretion on vessels	All coastal waters	Today through Saturday Morning














Forecast Storm Total Snowfall

Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast Valid: Today and Tonight









Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts (in MPH)

Max Wind Gusts (MPH)














Forecast Minimum Wind Chills

Threat Event Summary

✓ <u>Confidence</u>: High confidence in wind chills, gale warnings, and freezing spray. Moderate confidence in heavy snowfall and strong winds on Cape Cod & Nantucket.

✓ What:



Heavy snow and strong winds leading to hazardous travel and localized blizzard conditions possible. Up to 6" possible.



Wind chills as low as -20°F. This could cause frostbite in as little as 30 minutes on exposed skin.



Significant ice accretion on vessels at a rate of 2 cm per hour is possible.

- ✓ Where: All of Southern New England (MA, RI & CT)
- ✓ When: Wind chills until Noon. Heavy snow and strong winds Today and This Evening. Freezing spray for Today through Saturday morning.
