What Has Changed?

- ✓ Winter Storm Warning changed to Winter Weather Advisory on Marthas Vineyard, Block Island
- ✓ Winter Storm Warning now in effect in Northeast and Central MA, Northern RI, Northeast CT.
- ✓ Winter Weather Advisory now in effect for Western MA and for Hartford County CT.















Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Heavy Snow	Significant snow accumulations of 6+ inches, along with high snowfall rates, resulting in hazardous travel Wet snow may bring the risk for some power outages.	Highest snow amounts/rates in Eastern and Central MA/Northeast CT. Wet snow/power outage risk in RI and Southeast MA.	Beginning Sunday morning and ends Sunday evening














Summary of Potentially Greatest Impacts















Snowfall Onset Time on Sunday












Forecast Storm Total Snowfall










End Time of Snowfall on Sunday

Threat Event Summary

- ✓ <u>Confidence</u>: Confidence highest where the Winter Storm Warning has been issued. Uncertain on the northwest extent of heaviest snow, but confident in a plowable snow across most of Southern New England
- ✓ What:



Significant snow across much of Southern New England

- ✓ Where: Plowable snow anticipated across most of Southern New England. There is a risk for some power outages across southeast MA and RI due to heavy wet snow
- ✓ When: Sunday and early Sunday night


