What Has Changed?

- ✓ Winter Storm Warning for the South Coast and into SE MA
- ✓ Winter Storm Watch for much of the rest of southern New England
- ✓ Winter Weather Advisory for SW CT away from the coast















Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Heavy Snow	Significant snow accumulations of 6+ inches, along with high snowfall rates, resulting in hazardous travel	A significant part of southern New England will be impacted for travel Wet snow may bring the risk for some power outages in RI and southeast MA	Beginning Sunday morning and ends Sunday evening

Snowfall Onset Time on Sunday












Forecast Storm Total Snowfall
















End Time of Snowfall on Sunday

Threat Event Summary

- ✓ <u>Confidence</u>: Confidence highest where the Winter Storm Warning has been issued. Uncertain on the northwest extent of heaviest snow, but confident in a plowable snow across most of southern New England
- ✓ What:



Significant snow across much of southern New England

- ✓ Where: Plowable snow anticipated across most of southern New England. There is a risk for some power outages across southeast MA and RI due to heavy wet snow
- ✓ When: Sunday


