

OVERVIEW:

- Quick burst of snow expected Tuesday morning into early Tuesday evening.
- Could see anywhere from 2-5" across southern New England

TIMING	▪ Snowfall begins Tuesday morning and ends by the early evening.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Slick travel is possible as roads may become snow covered.<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Interior southern New England may see the morning commute impacted by the snow. All areas may be impacted for the afternoon commute.
