

Accumulating Snow Tuesday



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Snow expected into this evening.
- Additional snow accumulation 1-3 inches across southern New England. Areas along the immediate South Coast will likely mix with and change to rain this afternoon. Low probability of some freezing rain/drizzle towards the south coast of New England
- Winter Storm Warnings downgraded to Winter Weather Advisories

TIMING	▪ Snowfall ends 4-6 PM towards the Berkshires, 7-9 PM across most of southern New England, and 8-10 PM for east coastal MA	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Untreated surfaces become snow-covered. <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Most areas likely impacted for the afternoon commute.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Specific snowfall totals, especially areas along the south coast where rain will mix in	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Sunny on Wednesday with increasing clouds late. Breezy along the coast.▪ Highs range from the 20s across the higher elevations of the interior to the low 30s.
