


## OVERVIEW:

- Light snow and sleet transitioning to patchy freezing drizzle
- Snowfall a coating to an inch
- A light glaze more likely across RI and southeast MA

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Areas of light snow/sleet developing this evening along the south coast then patchy freezing drizzle by midnight.</li> <li>▪ Patchy drizzle/freezing drizzle Sunday.</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A dusting to an inch of snow combined with a light glaze of ice will result in hazardous travel with untreated roads becoming slippery.</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Uncertainty on areal coverage of any freezing drizzle. It is possible patchy freezing drizzle could develop in northern MA overnight.</li> </ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div data-bbox="254 966 499 1574"> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Patchy light wintry precipitation possible Mon.</li> <li>▪ A more significant storm is likely late Mon night/Tue with accumulating snow and ice, especially away from the south coast.</li> </ul> </div> <div data-bbox="542 956 1413 1574">  </div>
