

Possible Winter Storm late Mon/Tue



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Light wintry mix on Monday with light snow over the interior and a glaze of ice towards the South Coast.
- A major winter storm could bring several inches of snow/sleet along with significant ice accretion late Monday into Tuesday, particularly over interior MA, northern RI and CT.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Light wintry mix on Monday.▪ Significant ice accretion possible late Monday into Tuesday for all areas away from the immediate South Coast.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ For Monday, a dusting to an inch of snow combined with a light glaze of ice could result in hazardous travel with untreated roads becoming slippery.▪ For late Monday into Tuesday, significant ice accretion is possible over interior MA and CT. Several inches of snow are also possible north of the Mass Pike but biggest concern is the icing potential. Significant disruption to travel and power outages are possible.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ It is possible that we see more sleet and/or rain for the late Monday/Tuesday storm, which will cut down on ice accretion amounts.▪ A low track closer to the coast will result in the considerable icing zone further north into the interior but a further southerly track could bring icing potential all the way to the south coast.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather on Wednesday with highs in the mid 20s to low 30s.▪ A more significant storm is possible late Thursday into Friday with all precipitation types possible. <div data-bbox="568 1207 1406 1754"><p>Preliminary Ice Accretion Forecast Valid: Late Monday into Tuesday</p></div>
