## Winter Storm Mon Night/Tue



#### **OVERVIEW:**

- A winter storm could bring up to three inches of snow/sleet to northern MA, along with up to half an inch of ice accretion, particularly from northern CT to central and interior MA.
- A Winter Storm Watch has been issued for much of interior MA, northern CT and northern RI from late Monday into Tuesday.

# TIMING

- Snow, sleet and freezing rain late Monday and Monday evening transitioning to freezing rain overnight Monday night. Precipitation likely changing to rain for coastal areas and the Cape and Islands.
- Heaviest precipitation late Monday night into Tuesday morning.

## HAZARDS & IMPACTS

 Up to three inches of snow/sleet in northern MA along with significant ice accretion in the interior will result in hazardous travel along with potential for some tree damage and power outages.

### FORECAST CHALLENGES

- It is possible that we see more sleet and/or rain, which will cut down on ice accretion amounts.
- The axis of heaviest ice accretion is uncertain and could shift to the north,
- The southeast extent of any ice near the coast is uncertain.


