OVERVIEW:

- A winter storm could bring 1-3 inches of snow/sleet to northern MA, along with appreciable ice accretion, particularly from northern CT to central and interior NE MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Snow, sleet and freezing rain late Monday and Monday evening transitioning to freezing rain overnight Monday night. Precipitation changing to rain from Boston to Providence Monday night.Heaviest precipitation late Monday night into Tuesday morning.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">1-3 inches of snow in northern MA along with appreciable ice accretion in the interior will result in hazardous travel along with potential for some tree damage and power outages.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">It is possible that there is less snow and more ice in northern MA.The axis of heaviest ice accretion is uncertain and could shift to the north,The southeast extent of any ice near the coast is uncertain.
