- Winter Storm Watch issued for most of Southern New England
- Growing confidence in a plowable snowfall (4 to 7 inches) Thursday afternoon through Friday.
- Snow may change to ice and/or rain, especially near the south coast


## Snow begins Thursday Snow mixes with sleet/freezing rain over northern parts of CT/RI/SE Mass and may change to rain along the south coast by early Friday Precipitation ends Friday afternoon

## Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel The Thursday evening commute may be impacted but the greater impact will likely be during the Friday morning commute

## The northward extent of the rain-snow line Onset of the snow. Does it begin Thu or does it hold off until Thu evening? Snow amounts may be less or a bit more depending on the track and intensity of the storm

 Additional light snow accumulations possible Friday afternoon away from the coast
