

OVERVIEW:

- Growing confidence in a plowable snowfall (3 to 6 inches) late
 Thursday through Thursday night.
- Snow may change to ice and/or rain, especially near the south coast

TIMING	

- Snow begins late Thursday/Thursday evening
- A changeover to ice and/or rain is possible near the south coast by early
 Friday but this is not certain
- Precipitation ends Friday afternoon

HAZARDS &

- Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel
 The Thursday evening commute may be impacted.
- The Thursday evening commute may be impacted but the greater impact will likely be during the Friday morning commute

CHALLENGES


- The northward extent of the rain-snow line
- Onset of the snow. Does it begin Thu or does it hold off until Thu evening?
- Snow amounts may be less or a bit more depending on the track and intensity of the storm
