

## OVERVIEW:

- Growing confidence in a plowable snowfall (3 to 6 inches) late Thursday through Thursday night.
- Snow may change to ice and/or rain, especially near the south coast

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Snow begins late Thursday/Thursday evening</li> <li>▪ A changeover to ice and/or rain is possible near the south coast by early Friday but this is not certain</li> <li>▪ Precipitation ends Friday afternoon</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel</li> <li>▪ The Thursday evening commute may be impacted but the greater impact will likely be during the Friday morning commute</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The northward extent of the rain-snow line</li> <li>▪ Onset of the snow. Does it begin Thu or does it hold off until Thu evening?</li> <li>▪ Snow amounts may be less or a bit more depending on the track and intensity of the storm</li> </ul>
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Additional light snow accumulations possible Friday away from the coast</li> </ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Blustery and cold next weekend with highs 20s to lower 30s. Dry conditions.</li> </ul>
