

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Winter Weather Advisory for all of Southern New England.
- Plowable snowfall of 3 to 7 inches possible Thursday afternoon through Friday night.
- An all snow or nearly all snow event expected, except for the Cape and Islands where some sleet or rain may mix in on Friday.

| TIMING | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow begins Thursday afternoon, with the heaviest rates expected overnight.▪ The snowfall totals shown below will fall over a 36 to 48 hour period▪ Precipitation ends Friday night/early Saturday morning | |
| HAZARDS & IMPACTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel.▪ Thursday evening and Friday morning commutes could be impacted.▪ Impacts should be lessened given the prolonged nature of the storm. | |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ The northward extent of the heavier snow amounts.▪ Onset of the snow. Does it begin Thu or does it hold off until Thu evening?▪ Snow amounts may be less depending on the storm track and intensity.▪ Does a secondary wave develop on Friday? If so, snow intensity may pick up again over Eastern MA and higher end of snowfall range will be realized. | |
| ADDITIONAL INFORMATION | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Heavy snowfall rates are not likely. | |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Blustery and cold next weekend with highs 20s to lower 30s. Dry conditions. |  |
