## OVERVIEW:

- Winter Weather Advisory for all of Southern New England.
- Band of heavy snow exits south coastal areas this evening.
- Periods of mainly light snow into Friday night. Ocean-enhanced snow may lead to steady, moderate snow in eastern MA Friday afternoon/evening.
- Some sleet or rain may mix in tonight and Friday Cape Cod/Islands.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Band of heavy snow exits south coast this evening (4+” already fell there)</li><li>▪ Periods of snow, mainly light, through Friday evening. Ocean-enhanced snow may increase snowfall in eastern MA Fri. afternoon/evening.</li><li>▪ The snowfall totals shown below will be for the entire storm (Thu through Fri. night)</li><li>▪ Precipitation ends Friday night</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel.</li><li>▪ Minor impact possible to Friday morning commute. Impacts to Friday evening commute expected in eastern MA if ocean-enhanced snow bands get going.</li><li>▪ Overall, impacts will be lessened because these totals are over a 36 hours period.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Does the secondary wave intensify before it exits on Friday? If so, snow intensity may pick up again over eastern MA and higher end of snowfall range will be realized over eastern MA.</li><li>▪ Northwestern areas may not get as much as forecast.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Blustery and cold this weekend with highs 20s to lower 30s. Dry conditions.</li></ul>
