OVERVIEW:

- Winter Weather Advisory for all of Southern New England.
- 3 to 7 inches of snow possible this afternoon through Friday night.
- An all snow or nearly all snow event is expected, except for the Cape and Islands where some sleet or rain may mix tonight and Friday.

TIMING

- Snow begins later this morning in CT; early to mid afternoon south of the MA pike; this evening/early tonight in northern MA

 Steediest angular averaged late this effection and evening.
 - Steadiest snow expected late this afternoon and evening.
- The snowfall totals shown below will fall over a 36 to 48 hour period
- Precipitation ends Friday night/early Saturday morning

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel.
- This evening and Friday morning commutes could be impacted.
- Impacts will be lessened given the prolonged nature of the storm.

• Does the secondary wave intensify before it exits on Friday? If so, snow

intensity may pick up again over Eastern MA and higher end of snowfall


