

## OVERVIEW:

- Winter Weather Advisory for all of Southern New England.
- 3 to 7 inches of snow possible this afternoon through Friday night.
- An all snow or nearly all snow event is expected, except for the Cape and Islands where some sleet or rain may mix tonight and Friday.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow begins later this morning in CT; early to mid afternoon south of the MA pike; this evening/early tonight in northern MA</li><li>▪ Steadiest snow expected late this afternoon and evening.</li><li>▪ The snowfall totals shown below will fall over a 36 to 48 hour period</li><li>▪ Precipitation ends Friday night/early Saturday morning</li></ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel.</li><li>▪ This evening and Friday morning commutes could be impacted.</li><li>▪ Impacts will be lessened given the prolonged nature of the storm.</li></ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Does the secondary wave intensify before it exits on Friday? If so, snow intensity may pick up again over Eastern MA and higher end of snowfall range will be realized over eastern MA.</li></ul>	
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Heavy snowfall rates are not likely.</li></ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Blustery and cold this weekend with highs 20s to lower 30s. Dry conditions.</li></ul>	<p><b>Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast</b> Valid: Thursday through Friday Night</p>
