

Continuing Snowfall Through Tonight



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Winter Weather Advisory for all of Southern New England.
- Periods of mainly light snow into tonight. Ocean-enhanced snow may lead to steady, moderate snow in eastern MA this afternoon & evening.
- Some sleet or rain may mix in today over Cape Cod & the Islands.

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| TIMING | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Periods of snow, mainly light, through this evening. Ocean-enhanced snow may increase snowfall in eastern MA this afternoon/evening.▪ Precipitation ends across western MA/CT 7 to 9 PM; 10 PM to 2 AM for RI & eastern MA▪ Light ocean-effect snow showers may continue over Plymouth county, the Cape, and islands through noon Saturday |
| HAZARDS & IMPACTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow covered roads may lead to hazardous travel.▪ Minor impact possible to this morning's commute. Impacts to this evening's commute expected in eastern MA if ocean-enhanced snow bands get going.▪ Overall, impacts will be lessened because these totals are spread over an extended time frame. |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Does the secondary wave intensify before it exits today? If so, snow intensity may pick up again over eastern MA and higher end of snowfall range will be realized over eastern MA.▪ Northwestern areas may not get as much as forecast. |
