OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating wet snow over higher elevations Monday afternoon.
- Main concern is travel impacts during the evening commute, especially over higher elevations.

TIMING

- Snow develops noon to 2 pm Monday across western MA and northern CT and by 3 pm across interior northeast MA.
- Precipitation ends 6-9 pm Monday evening from west to east.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- 2 to 3 inches of snow over higher elevations in northern CT and central and western MA. Low risk for up to 4 inches across the east slopes of the Berkshires, northern Worcester Hills and Litchfield Hills.
- Snow covered roads will result in hazardous travel conditions.
- The evening commute will be impacted.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

• Snow accumulations over lower elevation areas in the interior.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Brief snowfall rates up to I inch per hour possible.
- Mainly rain is expected in the coastal plain from Boston to Providence.
 Precip may begin as brief snow or rain/snow mix from Boston to north
- shore.

- Low temps dropping into the upper 20s to lower 30s Mon night.
- Mainly dry and seasonable Tue with highs upper 30s to lower 40s
